HIALEAH CANCELS AFTER EIGHTH

SUNDAY A ferocious thunderstorm late Sunday afternoon unloaded heavy rain on Hialeah's racing surfaces; citing potentially dangerous track conditions, management cancelled the last three races on the card. The storm hit as the eighth race was being run. The GIII Hialeah Turf Cup, headlined by Fraise, had been scheduled as the ninth. Hialeah Executive Vice President and General Manager John Van Lindt announced that the Turf Cup would be rescheduled for next Saturday. All of Sunday's patrons were offered rainchecks good through closing day of the meet, May 22.

DERBY FAVORITE BREEZES Kentucky Derby favorite **Holy Bull** (Great Above) breezed an easy five furlongs at Keeneland Sunday, getting the distance in 1:02 1/5 with exercise rider Bobby Perna in the irons. The colt is scheduled to ship to Churchill Downs Saturday and will have his next work over the Churchill strip next Monday.

RICHARD BRUMBAUGH PROMOTED AT SANTA ANITA Richard D. Brumbaugh, formerly controller of the Los Angeles Turf Club Inc., has been named chief financial officer and vice president--finance of Santa Anita Operating Company and LATC Inc. The selection was made by the Santa Anita board of directors; Brumbaugh has been with the Santa Anita companies since 1972. A graduate of California State University, Northridge, Brumbaugh is a former assistant professor of finance at Cal State Los Angeles.

PIRATE'S REVENGE EYES KENTUCKY OAKS Trainer Ron Ellis may send **Pirate's Revenge** (Pirate's Bounty), winner of Friday's Twilight Ridge S. at Santa Anita, to Churchill for the May 6 Kentucky Oaks. The three-year-old Cal-bred earned her fourth straight victory in just five career starts in the Twilight Ridge.

PRIX DE CROUTON INJURED Tampa Bay Derby winner **Prix de Crouton** (Vilzak), who was pointing for the '94 Queen's Plate, was injured while training at Keeneland Friday and will be sidelined indefinitely. The three-year-old suffered a strained check ligament. News cont. p2

The margin at the finish was only three-quarters of a length, but jockey Chris McCarron was confident of the victory aboard 2-5 favorite Bien Bien. "He's a thrill to ride--an absolute thrill," said the Hall of Fame rider. "It's always nice to ride a horse of this calibre, but it's especially nice to be with one for the length of time I've been with him. He's turned into the best horse on the West Coast right now. Quite frankly, I was confident all the way to the wire." The win gave McCarron 16 stakes victories, most for a rider at the Santa Anita meet. Trainer Paco Gonzalez indicated that the accomplished five-year-old would make his next start in the Hollywood Turf Cup May 30, then possibly try the dirt in the Hollywood Gold Cup July 2. "He ran a big race; you know, he just tries every time," said Gonzalez. "He's doing so good. He actually put weight on from the last race." The winner is a 1/2 to Dr. Schwartzman (Fluorescent Light), MGSW, \$380,362 and Fantasy Lover (Raja Baba), SW, \$106,070.

Nine turf runners go a mile and a quarter for the \$100,000a purse in Santa Anita's closing day feature. **Lord Of The Field** (GB) (Jalmoood) totes the highweight in his first start in the U.S. Away from the races since finishing off the board in the Gill St. Simon S. at Newbury last Oct., the English and Irish GSW won four of 15 on foreign soil; he was also third in the GI Irish Champion S. He faces Kentucky-bred **Olanthe** (Blushing Groom), who was five wide when fifth in the April 3 Miramontes H. last time out in his first start in three months; and the speedy **Square Cut** (Assert), wire-to-wire winner of the Cedar Key H.
