SAM HOUSTON OPENS TODAY Texas' first Class 1 racing facility, Sam Houston Race Park, opens its doors today to a crowd which will be limited to 15,000. The \$84 million facility starts its 45-day run with purses set at \$150,000 per day based on an anticipated daily handle of \$1.5 million per day. The opening-day features the \$100,000 Governor's Day Handicap for three-year-olds and up.

LAKEWAY TO KENTUCKY OAKS Lakeway (Seattle Slew), who had been considered for the May 7 Kentucky Derby, will instead run in the Kentucky Oaks the prior day, according to Gene Short, jockey agent for Kent Desormeaux, who rides the filly. While trainer Gary Jones was said to be reserving judgement on the decision until he arrives in Kentucky, Short felt the decision had been made. "I've been told I'll be riding her Friday," said Short. Lakeway worked a mile in 1:39 2/5 over a muddy Churchill strip yesterday.

DERBY BRIEFS Meadow Flight (Meadowlake) had an eventful 6-furlong work in 1:13 1/5 Thursday morning. Trainer Jim Ryerson had hoped the Flamingo S. winner would go an easy three-quarters, but the colt hooked up with Forty Won, who was just starting a 5/8ths work. "It didn't go exactly as planned, but it got the job done," said Ryerson. "I think now I will blow him out closer to the race because he did a lot more today than we anticipated." **Smilin Singin Sam** (Smile) worked 6 furlongs in 1:15, galloping out 7/8ths in 1:28 3/5 under trainer Niall O'Callaghan, who pronounced himself "delighted" with the work.

Inside the final furlong, Balanchine, Las Meninas and Coup de Genie went on, line abreast, with Las Meninas and Balanchine fighting it out right at the line, where they were separated by a cigarette paper. Las Meninas's trainer, Tommy Stack, an Irishman who trains in County Tipperary, made his name as a jump jockey and partnered the mighty **Red Rum** when he won his third Aintree Grand National.

OAKLAWN WRAP-UP Closing day of the 1994 Oaklawn Park meeting produced the second-largest total handle in the track's history; \$7,700,442 was wagered on the 11-race Arkansas Derby card. Total handle for the meet was a record \$192,858,584 for a daily average of \$3,110,622, up 11 percent from 1993, but on-track handle dropped 6.6 percent and on-track attendance slipped 9.25 percent. Average daily on-track attendance was 15,784 as compared to 17,393 last year. Bobby Barnet led the trainer standing with 35 wins, while Pat Day took his 12th consecutive riding title with 86 victories.

\$1 MILLION CANADIAN-BRED PROGRAM ANNOUNCED

A \$1 million program designed as an incentive to buy and race in Ontario was announced today by members of the Ontario Thoroughbred Racing Industry. The program will provide \$500,000 annually in awards to breeders of Canadian-bred horses which win allowances at Woodbine and Fort Erie, and \$500,000 in awards to owners of Ontario-bred horses which win allowance races at the two tracks. Allowance races restricted to Canadian-breds will be eliminated, and a guaranteed payment of \$1,500 to both the breeder and owner when an Ontario-bred wins an allowance.

COMEBACK TRAILS Trainer Alex Hassinger said that he expects to get 1992 champion juvenile filly **Eliza** (Mt. Livermore) to the races before the July 25 close of the Hollywood Park meeting. Eliza worked five furlongs in :59 2/5 Tuesday. Meanwhile, **Star of Cozzene** (Cozzene) has progressed to five-furlong workouts on his comeback trail, according to trainer Mark Hennig. "We're still not singling out any races for him, but he will definitely run here before the end of the meet."

OBS SALE CONCLUDES, UP The Ocala Breeders' Sales Co. concluded its four-day Spring Two-Year-Olds-In Training Sale Thursday night with a total of 618 horses which sold for an average of \$11,322. The average was up 2.3% over last year's \$11,059. This year's gross was \$6,997,000. The sales topper, **Black Balled**, a colt by North Prospect--First Pet, by Ginistrelli, consigned by Curt Rice, agent, was purchased by Nick Demeric, agent, for \$155,000 at the final Thursday night session.
