**BIG 'CAP FINISH STANDS** The California Horse Racing Board agreed Thursday to uphold the decisions of the stewards who disqualified **The Wicked North** (Far North) from first and placed him fourth in the March 5 Santa Anita H., and suspended jockey Kent Desormeaux for five days. The Board was acting on the recommendations of Steve Schwartz, the hearing referee who considered the appeals of The Wicked North's owners, Philip and Sophia Hersh, and of Desormeaux, during a six-hour hearing March 19. In his review of the case, Schwartz stated, "The evidence supports a finding that the drift-out by The Wicked North at or about the 5/16-pole established a new lane for him and created one for Myrakalu. Having established a new lane, The Wicked North was not privileged to try to reoccupy the old one where to do so meant crossing over into Myrakalu so as to compel Myrakalu to take up and shorten its stride." Schwartz added that Desormeaux, "was so well aware of his position relative to the positions of the other horses that this unfortunate incident should never have happened."

**Thoro-Graph Analysis**

Sportsman's Park hosts its biggest race Saturday, and most of the participants will be negotiating the tight turns of this three-quarter mile track for the first time. At least the field is small this year at seven starters, about half as many as usual. The reason for that is the presence of **Polar Expedition** (Kodiack), a small horse who casts a big shadow.

On the surface, Polar Expedition looks to have it all his own way--he has: seven wins (six of them stakes) in nine starts, the early speed so valuable for this track, and "class." He would have taken serious action in that other Derby--you know, the one in Louisville. His figures are better than anyone else's, too, but he's spotting weight worth a couple of lengths and he is coming off two good figures. As we discussed last week, quality three-year-olds in the spring tend to run two good ones, bounce, then run big (as Southern Rhythm did in the Lexington). Polar Expedition is tough, but not unbeatable.

**Rustic Light** (Country Pine) is doing everything right. He's had a month since his last, two bullet workouts over the track, and is pointing at his best race. We'll take Rustic Light to win, but since we're not crazy, we'll also protect with an exacta under Polar Expedition. *Thoro-Graph sheets, state-of-the-art performance figures, are used by many horsemen and professional handicappers to evaluate the ability of racehorses. The New York-bred will try to repeat her '93 performance as she begins her '94 campaign. "She's ready. My feeling is they'll have to beat McKaymackenna, but...I don't think this is an easy spot," said trainer Rene Araya. The five-year-old will face French graded stakes winner **Cox Orange** (Tremolino), who was second, beaten 3/4's in the Rowan H. Nov. 7 in her only U.S. start.
