**CHRB DECISION CHALLENGED** The California Horse Racing Board upheld the decision to disqualify the '94 Santa Anita H. winner and suspend his jockey, Kent Desormeaux, but the owner of The Wicked North, Philip Hersh, says he will take the matter to court. "It's time to play hard ball," said Hersh, a 75-year-old retired plumbing contractor who bought The Wicked North for \$10,000 as a yearling. "I wasn't originally planning to appeal, but after reading the transcripts from the hearing, I have to go ahead and do what I think is right." Loretta Selinger, Hersh's daughter and attorney, says she will file an appeal within 10 days at Los Angeles Superior Court, adding the process may take six months. Selinger will attempt to have a judge, or a referee at a new hearing, consider testimony not permitted by CHRB appointee Steve Schwartz. Selinger had attempted to have Dr. Carley Ward, a biomechanical engineer, introduce aerial photographs which purportedly showed that Hill Pass, the sixth-place finisher in the Big 'Cap, came off the rail and interfered with Myrakalu inside the 5/16-pole. Kent Desormeaux, who was suspended for five days for his ride on The Wicked North, has been granted a stay until May 20 by the Superior Court and is free to ride Lakeway in the Kentucky Oaks Friday and Soul of the Matter in the Kentucky Derby Saturday.

**BELMONT PARK SPRING MEET OPENS TUESDAY** The final legs of both the Chrysler Triple Crown Challenge and the Early Times Triple Turf as well as the Handicap Triple Crown and the Triple Tiara highlight the 69-day Belmont Park spring meet, which opens Tuesday, May 3. A total of 41 stakes, including 10 Grade I's, will be featured. The New York track will run Tuesdays through Sundays; Mondays will be dark with the exception of Memorial Day, the Fourth of July and July 18. First post is 1:00 p.m. News cont. p2

A winner of three of his five starts at two, including two graded stakes, the English-bred colt was making his first start since last Sept. The time was the fastest ever recorded for a mile race at Newmarket, and eclipsed Zafonic's 2,000 Guineas record, set last year, by 0.24 seconds.

**DERBY NOTES** An appointment with the blacksmith almost cost **Blumin Affair** (Dynaformer) his morning gallop Saturday; the Arkansas Derby runner-up was fitted with new shoes yesterday morning and by the time he arrived trackside, the Churchill Downs oval had been closed for training. But track superintendent Butch Lehr heard of the problem before the colt had returned to his barn, and reopened the track. Explaining the importance of his charge's change of footwear, trainer Jack Van Berg said, "He burned his heels just a little bit at Arkansas and I don't want to take a chance of him burning them again. We changed to the shoe that we use that keeps him from doing that. He will run in these shoes." **Holy Bull** (Great Above) and **Valiant Nature** (His Majesty) arrived from Keeneland Saturday afternoon.
