DERBY HOPEFUL PREPS AT CHURCHILL

With new jockey Chris McCarron in the saddle, Wood Memorial runner-up **Go for Gin** (Cormorant) breezed six furlongs in 1:15 at Churchill Downs Sunday, covering the last quarter in :23 3/5 and the last eighth in :11 4/5. The colt galloped out seven furlongs in 1:28 3/5. "He was rolling down the lane," said McCarron. "He was so relaxed going off, I just let him go. He feels terrific."

RED RANSOM'S FIRST WINNER Seven-year-old **Red Ransom** (Roberto), a freshman sire for 1994, had his first winner Saturday when his two-year-old son **Sri Pekan** came back from a second-place finish in his debut to win a five-furlong maiden event at Newmarket in England. Bred by Hargus Sexton and Sandra Ellsworth, the 1/2 to SW **Dusty's Command** (Bob's Dusty) is trained in England by Paul Cole; he was a \$105,000 Keeneland September yearling. **Red Ransom**, who set a Saratoga track record and won two of his three career starts, stands at the Vinery in Midway, Kentucky for a \$7,500 stud fee.

NAKATANI TO RETURN FRIDAY? Jockey Corey Nakatani, sidelined since Apr. 2 with a fractured right ankle, could return to action as early as Friday. "He's way ahead of schedule," said his agent, Bob Meldahl. "He goes to his doctor (Monday), and if they decide that the cast can come off, he could be able to ride Friday."

WAITRYST RETIRED New Zealand-bred **Waitryst** (Bassenthwaite {GB}), a winner of three straight Santa Anita allowance races before finishing third in the GI Santa Barbara H. in her most recent start, has been retired. Her trainer, Frank Olivares, said the five-year-old suffered a training injury and has been sold as a broodmare to interests in Ocala, Florida.
