GO FOR GIN SPLASHES HIS WAY TO DERBY VICTORY

Go For Gin (Cormorant), held at 9-1 despite showing a distinct fondness for the slop in two big wins at two, went right to the front under a snug hold, turned back a challenge on the far turn and carried jockey Chris McCarron to a clear, two-length victory in yesterday's Kentucky Derby. "He got his track and that's what it's about--you've got to be lucky and blessed and once again the good Lord rocked me in his arms," said trainer Nick Zito, who saddled Strike the Gold to win the Derby in '91. Go For Gin will try to pick up the second leg of the Triple Crown in the Preakness at Pimlico in two weeks. **Holy Bull** (Great Above) was flat-footed at the start and never threatened the leader; just off the pace early, he weakened badly and became the 15th straight Derby favorite to go down to defeat.

DERBY WINNERS GET PRESIDENTIAL

CALL President Bill Clinton, whose late mother Virginia Kelly was a racing fan, phoned Churchill Downs late Saturday afternoon to offer his personal congratulations to the winners of the '94 Derby. Owner Joe Cornacchia extended an invitation to the President to visit the colt at Pimlico. "I might take you up on Baltimore," said the President. He also commented on the rainy weather at Louisville, but trainer Nick Zito answered, "Yes, Mr. President, but the sun is shining now."

BILL NACK ELECTED N.T.W.A. PRESIDENT

Six-time Eclipse Award-winning writer Bill Nack, senior writer for Sports Illustrated, was elected Friday to a two-year term as president of the National Turf Writers Association. Nack succeeds New York free-lance writer Jenny Kellner, the first woman to serve as president of the 35-year-old organization. Pohla Smith was elected vice-president.

Owners William Condren and Joseph Cornacchia (co-owners, Strike the Gold) are now a perfect two-for-two in the race. The winner is a 1/2 to Ch. After winning the Westchester from just off the pace, Virginia Rapids closed from far back to take the Carter H. for his second straight graded stakes win, and his first-ever Grade I. "This was a big thrill," said trainer Allen Jerkens. "Jean (jockey Jean-Luc Samyn) has been working a lot with him in the mornings. It's starting to pay off now...since March, he's sizzling." The 1/2 to Virgin Michael (Green Dancer), MSW, \$348,572, will make his next start in the Met Mile Memorial Day. Favored at 9-5, Cherokee Run got the lead in the stretch but couldn't hold off the top two. "Couldn't ask him to run any harder," said his rider, Robbie Davis. "He is so honest. He didn't slow up--they just kind of ran us down."
