Millstream, who is out of the Damascus mare Aquabar, took the EBF Zetland Maiden Fillies S. at York in England May 10. Dayjur, whose first yearlings sold in North America for an average of \$340,714 last year, has 41 foals in his current two-year-old crop.

**SEA HERO NEARS RETURN** 1993 Kentucky Derby winner Sea Hero (Polish Navy) has been nominated to the May 30 Metropolitan Mile at Belmont Park. The colt has recorded two workouts over the Belmont main track since his recovery from knee surgery and a second surgery to remove a sarcoid from his chest. He went a half-mile in :48.93 last Tues., and breezed six furlongs in 1:15.62 Sun. The colt's connections said that he would make his '94 debut in an allowance race 'in the next week or so' before a determination regarding the Met is made.

**GO FOR GIN ARRIVES AT PIMLICO** Kentucky Derby Winner Go For Gin (Cormorant) arrived by van at Pimlico Race Course just before midnight Tues. and will begin his preparations for next Sat.'s 119th running of the Grade I, \$500,000 Preakness. "He shipped well and looks great," said trainer Nick Zito. "He ran a big race in the Derby and came out of it fine." Go For Gin currently occupies Stall 40, which is traditionally reserved for the Kentucky Derby winner. "It's great to be here," said Zito. "We're looking forward to the Preakness. This is an honest horse. He never runs a bad race. People like to talk about how well he ran over the slop at Churchill, but he can run real well on any type of track."
