## EASY GOER DIES AT AGE EIGHT

Ogden Phipps' Easy Goer (Alydar), died Thursday at 1:30 p.m. of a possible heart attack at Claiborne Farm in Paris, Kentucky, where he was standing at stud. The results of an autopsy are pending. Shug McGaughey, who trained 1988's champion two-year-old said that he was informed of the stallion's death by Claiborne owner Seth Hancock. "Seth told me that they whistled for him in his paddock," said McGaughey. "He came down and he just went to his knees and that was it. They will be taking autopsies and I think it may show that he had a heart attack." "We turned him out after breeding, which is standard procedure," said Gus Cook, assistant manager at Claiborne. "It shocked us. You don't expect it from a nice healthy horse like that. He was in beautiful health. I saw him today in the breeding shed and he was gorgeous. He was just grand. It was a shock to think a horse like this could just collapse and die." Out of the mare Relaxing, Easy Goer was Alydar's second-leading money winner (to Alysheba's \$6.6 million), retiring at age four with earnings of \$4,873,770, a total that placed him fourth on the all-time money list. As a sire, Easy Goer has 72 registered foals, 36 in each of his first two crops (1992 and '93). They are yet to race. Easy Goer will be best remembered for his dramatic four-race rivalry with Sunday Silence. He reversed Derby and Preakness losses with a stirring eight-length victory in the Belmont Stakes before conceding the Breeders' Cup Classic to him by a neck. He was retired when a chip on his right front sesamoid was discovered while he was in training for the Aug. 4, 1990 Arlington Challenge Cup.

## TRIPLE THREATS:

**Ulises** (Temperence Hill), last, beaten more than 35 lengths in the Kentucky Derby, is expected to join a field of up to 12 starters in the Preakness. Ulises was undefeated in four starts in Panama before fading to third in Keeneland's Lexington S. last month. Trainer Randy Winick informed the Pimlico Racing Department yesterday that **Brocco** (Kris S.) is doubtful for the Preakness, but that a final decision has not yet been made. The probable field now appears to be: **Go For Gin** (Cormorant), **Silver Goblin** (Silver Ghost), **Holy Bull** (Great Above), **Tabasco Cat** (Storm Cat), **Polar Expedition** (Kodiack), **Concern** (Broad Brush), **Blumin Affair** (Dynaformer), **Kandaly** (Alydar), **Numerous** (Mr. Prospector), **Powis Castle** (Rare Brick) and **Ulises**.

**EDDERY TO SPLIT WITH ABDULLAH** Britain's champion jockey Pat Eddery will not be riding on a retainer to Saudi Prince Khalid Abdullah next year. Their association, which began when Eddery successfully partnered Dancing Brave to win the 1986 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond Stakes, comes to an end by mutual consent at the end of this season. Abdullah has so far revealed no plans to employ another jockey for 1995. His racing manager, Grant Pritchard-Gordon, said, "contracts have always been the Prince's affair."

**CHANGES AT SAM HOUSTON** Sam Houston Race Park has announced plans to offer full-card simulcasting Sundays and Mondays from Trinity Meadows, Arlington Park and Louisiana Downs beginning Sunday, May 21. General Manager Jim Murphy also announced that the Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday programs would be shortened from ten to nine live races. The simulcast schedule is pending approval of the Texas Racing Commission. "Cutting back a race a day should help out a great deal," said Murphy. "Our Friday, Saturday, and Sunday programs will still have 10 races on the card."

**LAKEWAY EYES HOLLYWOOD OAKS** Lakeway, who suffered her first defeat in five career starts to Sardula in the Kentucky Oaks, is back at Hollywood Park and pointing to the July 10 \$200,000 Hollywood Oaks, according to trainer Gary Jones. "She came out of the (Oaks) okay," said Jones, who added that she may prep in the June 4 Railbird S. or the June 18 Princess S.
