HOLY BULL TO MISS PREAKNESS Holy Bull, the 2-1 favorite who finished 13th in the Kentucky Derby, will skip the Preakness following treatment for a blood count disorder. Holy Bull is expected to miss several days of training, but is being aimed for the Met Mile at Belmont May 30. "Nothing is seriously wrong with him," said trainer Jimmy Croll. "The blood tests came back this morning. There's nothing drastically wrong, just a couple of small things we need to work on." Lenny Hale, Pimlico's VP of racing, said that Croll told him the horse will be on antibiotics for the next three or four days.

WINICK MAKES IT OFFICIAL Trainer Randy Winick officially confirmed Brocco's status as a non-starter in the Preakness, but said that he would aim for the Belmont Stakes June 11. Winick, on hand to watch the colt gallop at Churchill Friday morning, said, "I don't see him having any problem with the mile and a half of the Belmont. He's back to himself. He runs hard every time and he kind of knocks himself out." Winick said that the Derby took a little more out of him than a normal race and that the colt would gallop through the weekend before working five furlongs early in the week. "We'll go on to New York after than and then we'll give him a little time off after the Belmont and look to come back with him at Del Mar," said Winick.

RACING CANCELLED AT BANDERA DOWNS No live racing was conducted at Bandera Downs on Friday due to heavy rains which flooded the area. Chief Operating Officer Brian Elmore made the announcement after jockeys felt that the track was unsafe.

The weak 3-year-old crops of the last couple of years have created the lackluster handicap division of '94, and will probably result in domination of this fall's weight-for-age contests by this year's sophomore crop. Meanwhile, what older talent there is gathers in Baltimore this weekend for the strongest handicap race thus far this year. **Devil His Due** (Devil's Bag) and **Pistols and Roses** (Darn That Alarm) are solid horses, but neither is particularly scary. **As Indicated** (Czaravich) has made a strong transition from mediocre 3-year-old to serious 4-year-old--his last two figures are the best run at a route this year and if he is capable of three in a row, he'll win. The value in the race, however, is **Greatsilverfleet** (On To Glory), who also developed strongly late in his three-year-old campaign. This colt just had a wind operation, and some huge workouts since--and with a weight pull, speed and the rail, is a clear play. Greatsilverfleet to win, and protect with an exacta under As Indicated.
