CHRB ISSUES COMPLAINTS AGAINST SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA TRAINERS The California Horse Racing Board yesterday issued complaints against four Southern California-based Thoroughbred trainers whose horses, in post-race urine samples, tested positive for the drug scopolamine. The trainers (and horses) involved are Ron McAnally (Delacroix), Mark Hennig (Lady Blessington {FR}), Richard Mandella (Water Prospector) and Willard Proctor (Top Rung). April 21 the CHRB issued an informational bulletin advising horsemen of the confirmed presence of a weed containing the prohibited substance in bedding straw that was delivered to tracks in Southern California.

PREAKNESS UPDATE Pimlico Vice President of Racing Lenny Hale said Sat. that **Smilin Singin Sam** (Smile), 10th in the Kentucky Derby, may go postward in the 119th running of the Preakness S. "Cot Campbell of Dogwood Stable told me that Smilin Singin Sam may come here," said Hale. "The horse will work Mon., and then they'll give us a call." Charlie Whittingham trainee **Numerous** (Mr. Prospector) had his first serious work at Pimlico yesterday morning, going seven furlongs in 1:27 and galloping out the mile in 1:42. "It was a really nice move," said Sonia Simmons, the colt's exercise rider. "He did it easy." A \$1.7 million yearling purchase, Numerous won the GII Derby Trial at Churchill Downs in his last start. The probable Preakness field also includes **Go For Gin** (Cormorant), **Blumin Affair** (Dynaformer), **Tabasco Cat** (Storm Cat), **Powis Castle** (Rare Brick), **Ulises** (Temperence Hill), **Polar Expedition** (Kodiack), **Concern** (Broad Brush), **Kandaly** (Alydar) and **Silver Goblin** (Silver Ghost). **Looming** (Broad Brush) is listed as possible for the race.

SOUTHERN RHYTHM UNDERGOES

SURGERY Southern Rhythm (Dixieland Band), seventh in the Kentucky Derby, underwent surgery Sat. morning for removal of a bone chip in his left front ankle. That will probably put him on the shelf for several months, said trainer Jim Keefer. Dr. Alex Harthill was scheduled to perform the surgery.

LAKEWAY POSSIBLE FOR MOTHER GOOSE

Lakeway (Seattle Slew), second in the GI Kentucky Oaks, will probably make her next start in the second leg of the Triple Tiara, the GI Mother Goose S. at Belmont. "We're looking at the Mother Goose on June 12," said trainer Gary Jones. "The thinking is if you're going to be champion, you have to win in New York and you have to beat **Inside Information** (Private Account)." Inside Information has already won the first leg of the Triple Tiara, the Acorn S. Jones indicated that Kent Desormeaux would retain the mount on Lakeway in the Mother Goose.

BERTRANDO TO ARRIVE AT HOLLYWOOD

TODAY Ed Nahem, co-owner of multiple GI winner **Bertrando** (Skywalker), said the horse will arrive today at Hollywood Park where he will resume training after a tour at stud. "He'll be at my barn and under my jurisdiction," said Nahem. Bertrando serviced some 70 mares at River Edge Farm in Calif. after undergoing knee surgery. "I'd say he's two months away from running," Nahem continued. "He's been galloping at the farm. If everything works out, our long-range plans include going back to New York for the Jockey Club Gold Cup and the Woodward."

SMITH RECEIVES AWARD

1993 Eclipse Award-winning jockey Mike Smith has been named the 1994 recipient of the Mike Venezia Memorial Award. The award is a tribute given to the jockey who best exemplifies the qualities of sportsmanship and citizenship that were paramount to Mike Venezia, the New York rider who was tragically killed in a spill at Belmont Park in Oct., 1988. "It's a great honor," said Smith, who will be given the award in a special ceremony in the Belmont Park winner's circle Memorial Day.

SANTA CATALINA RETIRED

Santa Catalina (Cure the Blues), winner over the winter of the GIII Shirley Jones and First Lady Handicaps at Gulfstream Park, has been retired from racing. Best in 9 of 29 races, the \$290,083-earner was bred in April to A. P. Indy, to whom she has been checked in foal. Lane's End Farm will consign the 6-year-old mare to the 1994 Keeneland Nov. Breeding Stock Sale.
