## SMALL TO RUN TWO HORSES IN

**PREAKNESS** Trainer Richard Small will start both Arkansas Derby winner **Concern** (Broad Brush) and **Looming** (Broad Brush) in Sat's 119th running of the Preakness. "I'm real comfortable with both of them," Small said of the Robert Meyerhoff-owned pair. "Since they first started working they've been about even, they've been good, and I still can't say that one's better than the other." The two horses worked a mile together Mon. morning in 1:41. The colts' sire, Broad Brush, finished third in the 1986 Preakness.

**POWIS CASTLE POSTS SOLID WORK** Vistas Stables' **Powis Castle** (Rare Brick) was reunited Tues. with Brent Bartram, the jockey who rode him to three straight wins as a two-year-old, and moved easily through a five-furlong work in 1:00 3/5 over a fast Pimlico surface. "That was good," said Chris Bell, assistant to trainer Rodney Rash. "He wasn't really pushing him either, just niggling him a bit down the lane." Bartram replaces Derby jockey Chris Antley.

**KANDALY ZIPS FIVE FURLONGS IN :59 3/5** Louisiana Derby winner **Kandaly** (Alydar) worked five furlongs Tues. in a swift :59 3/5 under jockey Edgar Prado. Trainer and part-owner Louie Roussel missed most of the work, although he was seated in his usual spot. Prado and Kandaly got to the five-eighths pole so quickly that Roussel didn't believe it was them breaking off. "That was my horse!" he yelled as Kandaly streaked by the eighth pole.

**TABASCO CAT BREEZES** **Tabasco Cat** (Storm Cat), sixth in the Derby, had his final work for the Preakness Tues. morning at Churchill Downs, going five furlongs in 1:01 3/5 over a fast strip. Pat Day, who will ride Sat., was in the irons. Trainer D. Wayne Lukas, in search of his third Preakness win, called the colt's effort a "good, solid work." **Tabasco Cat** will ship to Pimlico Wed.

## Sunday, Hollywood

**SHOEMAKER H.-GII, \$100,000a, 3&up, 8f(T)** Jockey Alex Solis will ride **Johann Quatz** (FR) (Sadler's Wells) for Hall of Fame trainer Ron McAnally. The five-year-old horse will be making his first start since finishing sixth to Hill Pass in the Jan. 22 GII San Pasqual H. at Santa Anita. **Megan's Interco** (Interco) is in top form; the five-year-old California-bred had won five straight, including three stakes, before finishing second to Shoemaker probable **Norwich** (GB) (Top Ville {IRE}) in the April 16 GII El Rincon H. at Santa Anita in his last start. Likely starters also include **Bon Point** (GB) (Soviet Star), a G3 winner in France, **Earl of Barking** (IRE) (Common Grounds {GB}), a four-time GSW in Southern California and **Rapan Boy** (AUST) (Yeats), a stakes-winner in Australia who is undefeated in one start in North America, the GIII San Simeon H. at Santa Anita April 23.

## Saturday, Hollywood

**WILL ROGERS H.-GIII, \$100,000a, 3yo, 8.5f(T)** Rodney Rash trainee **Cois Na Tine** (IRE) (Double Schwartz {IRE}), a G3 winner in Ireland, will be ridden by Kent Desormeaux. Other three-year-olds scheduled to start include MGSP **Gracious Ghost** (Relaunch), **Majestic Style** (Nureyev) and **Timbalier** (Sovereign Dancer). Trainer Bobby Frankel said his stakes-winner **Eagle Eyed** (Danzig) will not be entered.

Last year's Kentucky Derby winner Sea Hero, off since a 3rd-place finish in the Molson Million last Sept., raced behind pacesetter Dominant Prospect in the early stages, then drew off to a 1 1/4-length victory. "I'm glad it's over," said trainer MacK Miller. "I liked the race very much because he's really not a sprinter; he's a router." Sea Hero is 1/2 to Hero's Honor (MGI, \$499,025, by Northern Dancer), Wild Applause (GII, \$240,136, by Northern Dancer) and Glowing Honor (MGII, \$296,450, by Seattle Slew).

**5th-BEL, \$32,000, Alw, 3yo/up, f/m, 1 1/16f (off the turf), 1:45 2/5, my.**

**PERSONAL DANCER, (f, 4, Badger Land--Personification, by Personality),** the 7-5 favorite who drew into the race when it was taken off the turf, sat just off the early pacesetters before drawing off in the stretch to a 2 1/2-length score, her 2nd straight over a wet track.
