BROCCO ARRIVES IN NY Brocco (Kris S.), winner of the Breeders' Cup Juvenile and most recently fourth in the Kentucky Derby, arrived at Belmont Park Wed. night from Kentucky to prepare for the June 11 Belmont Stakes. "Everything was very smooth," said Alfredo Garcia, Brocco's exercise rider, yesterday of the colt's journey to New York. "He walked this morning. He breezed the day before yesterday, so he'll work again in about five days."

BARRETT'S SALE AVERAGE UP Barretts Equine Sales held its Two-Year-Olds in Training and Horses of Racing Age Sale at Fairplex Park May 17. There were 119 two-year-olds and 44 horses of racing age sold for a gross of \$2,121,500 and an average of \$13,015, up 62.7 percent from the 1993 average of \$7,999. The sales topper was **Dare to Duel**, a four-year-old colt by Kris S.--Mardi Gras Mombo (Tampa Trouble), who won the 1993 running of the Ocean-side S. at Del Mar. Dare to Duel was purchased by Narvick International, Inc. for \$140,000. The highest priced two-year-old at \$75,000 was an unnamed colt by Skywalker--Music House (IRE), consigned by Cardiff Stud Farms and purchased by Oak Cliff Stable.

HORSEMEN'S CHOICE SALE RESULTS At the Horsemen's Choice Two-Year-Olds in Training Sale Wed. at Laurel Race Course, 31 head were sold for a total of \$453,900 and an average of \$14,642. The sales topper, a bay filly by Dr. Blum--Sound Reasoning (IRE) (Known Fact), was purchased by Henry Kogstat for \$47,000.

Numerous (Mr. Prospector): The GIII Derby Trial winner posted a swift three-furlong workout in 35 seconds over a fast Pimlico track early Thurs. morning. "He's ready," said trainer Charlie Whittingham.

Blumin Affair (Dynaformer): The Jack Van Berg trainee, third in the Kentucky Derby, breezed an easy half-mile yesterday morning at Pimlico in :52 1/5. "He did it easy," said exercise rider/assistant trainer Mark Wallerstedt. "He was really within himself. When we turned for home, he picked it up on his own. I had a lot of hold on him. He'd have really worked fast this morning if I'd have let him."

Polar Expedition (Kodiack): The GII Jim Beam victor posted an easy half-mile work in :51 2/5 seconds yesterday morning at Pimlico. Trainer Hugh Robertson said the work was exactly what he was looking for. "I don't usually blow him out, but he's so sharp now," said Robertson.

Concern (Broad Brush), **Looming** (Broad Brush): The Robert Meyerhoff-owned pair galloped 1 1/2-miles over the Pimlico track yesterday morning. "I just hope I haven't overmatched these two," said trainer Richard Small. "Van Berg's horse (Blumin Affair) is the yardstick for us. Concern finished ahead of him in the Arkansas Derby, then Blumin Affair ran well in the Kentucky Derby. People say that the Kentucky Derby race makes him better than ours. I don't know why."

THORO-GRAPH ANALYSIS OF THE PREAKNESS

While the past 13 Kentucky Derby winners have run a big race shortly before the Derby, history tells us that many a Preakness winner (Tank's Prospect, Snow Chief, Hansel and Pine Bluff) have come off sub-par efforts to run the best race of their lives in Baltimore. Combined with the fact that many horses who run well in the Derby tend to bounce in the Preakness just two weeks later, and you have the scenario for some serious betting opportunities. This year should be no exception. **Go For Gin's** (Cormorant) long-term pattern is still great, his short term one is not, and we predict a small Preakness bounce of about two points, which makes him a marginal contender. **Blumin Affair** (Dynaformer) will take some money, but we expect him to run worse as well. **Numerous** (Mr. Prospector) and **Tabasco Cat** (Storm Cat) also figure to take some action at the window, but so far, are just not fast enough. There are four interesting horses, in no particular order, and they will all be big prices. **Polar Expedition** (Kodiack) ran two good ones, then threw in a clinker in the Illinois Derby. **Silver Goblin** (Silver Ghost) turned in a serious figure in March before bleeding in his next start. He ran a mediocre third in the Arkansas Derby when adding Lasix, but he's now had a month to prepare, and should give maximum effort. **Powis Castle** (Rare Brick) had a terrific pattern heading into the Derby, but failed to fire in Louisville and it may have been because of the slop. If he gets a dry track, he will run the race of his young life. One final thought--**Go For Gin** is part horse and part duck--obviously rain increases his chances and therefore decreases those of the others.
