NYRA NOT ALLOWED TO TAKE NATIONAL BEST SEVEN The New York Racing Association tracks will not be allowed to take the National Best Seven, according to Jim Gallagher, Chief of Racing Operations for the New York State Racing and Wagering Board. Gallagher said that statutes do not allow New York OTB outlets to take a wager with a greater host fee than 6.5%. Gallagher said that the TRA was planning to charge NY OTB a 10.05% host fee. While NYRA still wanted to take the race on-track, "generally what happens with these events is that everyone participates," said Gallagher. "We didn't want to have any exclusivity for anyone while excluding the OTBs. Gallagher said that the ongoing dispute with horsemen's groups and the fact that NYRA is only allowed to import 47 special events per year contributed to the decision.

CHURCHILL DOWNS REPORTS LOSSES Churchill Downs Inc. reported decreased revenues and earnings for the first quarter of 1994 which ended March 31. Net loss for the quarter was \$2,204,791 or 58 cents a share. Revenues were \$2,426,032 versus \$2,962,470 in 1993. "The decreases in meeting revenues and profits were due to weather-related cancellations of the equivalent of 13 race days during Jan. and Feb. at Turfway Park," said Thomas Meeker, President and CEO of Churchill Downs.

JOCKEY CLUB RELEASES FACT BOOK The Jockey Club yesterday released the 1994 edition of its annual statistical guide to the Thoroughbred industry, entitled "The Jockey Club Fact Book." The book summarizes current breeding, racing and public auction trends throughout the previous decade.
