**RUBBER MATCH SET FOR BELMONT** **Tabasco Cat** (Storm Cat) came out of the Preakness in excellent shape and will be pointed for the Belmont Stakes, according to trainer Wayne Lukas, who said he may take him back to Churchill to prepare for the third leg of the Triple Crown. Nick Zito said that he would ship **Go for Gin** (Cormorant) to Belmont Park Monday morning. "Hopefully, on his home court, he'll have a little bit of an advantage," said Zito, who expects Go for Gin to give Tabasco Cat a run for his money in the Belmont. "Did you see him at the end?" he asked reporters. "Go for Gin galloped out stronger than Tabasco Cat. It was like he was looking him in the eye and sending him a message." The only other Preakness starter definitely expected to join the duo is **Numerous** (Seattle Slew), who will join stablemate and Derby runner-up **Strodes Creek** (Halo) at Belmont.

**POWIS CASTLE BLED BADLY** Powis Castle bled badly through Lasix in the Preakness and will get and extended rest, according to assistant trainer Chris Bell. "On a scale of one to 10, it was a seven--he bled real bad," said Bell. "We'll just give him some time off now and get him ready for Del Mar."

**KANDALY BLED; PLANS UNCERTAIN** Fourth-place finisher **Kandaly** (Alydar) bled during the Preakness, but co-owner trainer Louie Roussel did not rule out a trip to the Belmont Stakes. "On a scale of one to five, it was probably a two," said Roussel. "It probably cost him third, that's it." Roussel said that he would take his time deciding where to go next with the colt, but said that New York's medication rules would have no bearing on his decision.

**HAPPY TRAILS...**The rest of the Preakness field will scatter across the country, with **Concern** (Broad Brush) heading to the Ohio Derby and **Looming** (Broad Brush) remaining in Maryland...Jack Van Berg feels **Blumin Affair** (Dynaformer) may have flipped his palate during the race, and will be returning to California with no firm plans for a race....**Silver Goblin** (Silver Ghost) will return to Chicago and may van to Cleveland for the Ohio Derby...and **Polar Expedition** (Kodiack), whose right stifle seems to be bothering him, will be rested for six weeks and shortened up to sprints.

Megan's Interco broke the one-mile Hollywood turf course record set by Miesque in her first Breeders' Cup Mile victory in 1987. Prompting the early pace, he settled in on the backstretch before challenging the early leader, Norwich, in the stretch and holding off Furiously under urging. "He's always battled the problems with his feet and he's got a new shoe on," said trainer Jenine Sahadi. "I would like to think this horse could run competitively in the Breeders' Cup at the end of the year, but that's a long ways away." Only a second-place finish in the El Rincon H. in his last start mars what would be a 7-race win streak.

**KRONE RETURNS WEDNESDAY** Jockey Julie Krone is scheduled to return to racing Wednesday at Belmont, where she has been listed aboard three horses, including Life Boat in the \$50,000 Bouwerie. Krone has not ridden in a race since shattering her ankle in an Aug. 30 spill at Saratoga.

**HOLLYWOOD WILDCAT WORKS FOR RETURN** Breeders' Cup Distaff winner **Hollywood Wildcat** (Kris S.) worked seven furlongs in a bullet 1:24 4/5 Sunday morning, preparing for a start in next Sunday's \$100,000-added Hawthorne H. at Hollywood Park. The Eclipse Award winner has not raced since finishing a distant third in the La Canada S. Feb. 5, and subsequently developed a cough. She has been training steadily for her summer/fall campaign since mid-March.

That figure is also a record, topping the \$19,338,393 million set in 1992. New York topped the list of simulcast sites with \$6,498,330, including OTBs and 12 off-track sites. Maryland attendance at the Preakness (which includes patrons at Pimlico, Laurel, Rosecroft and Delmarva) was also a record 99,834, topping 1989's 98,896.
