HOLLYWOOD PARK ENTERS BOXING

ARENA Hollywood Park in Inglewood, Calif. will make its first fast break ever into the boxing ring this summer when former heavyweight champion Riddick Bowe takes on the undefeated Larry Donald in a Fri. night bout at the racetrack July 15. The fight, the second in Bowe's three-fight summer series, will be staged outdoors next to the track's newly constructed card club, the Hollywood Park Casino. The Bowe-Donald bout marks the first time a professional boxing match will be staged at Hollywood and the first major outdoor heavyweight fight held in Los Angeles since 1967. Hollywood Park's night races July 15 will be moved to a daytime schedule that day, with the fight scheduled for 7 p.m. PST. HBO will televise the event live.

DERBY WINNER ARRIVES AT BELMONT

Kentucky Derby winner and Preakness runner-up **Go For Gin** (Cormorant) arrived by van at his Belmont Park base from Pimlico in Baltimore, Maryland yesterday afternoon. "Everything was smooth; he arrived right on time," said trainer Nick Zito. "He'll walk the shedrow under tack tomorrow, and he'll be out on the track Wed." The June 11 Belmont S. will be the next event on Go For Gin's dance card. "He seemed to come out of the Preakness in great shape, but you've always got to worry," Zito continued. "The Triple Crown takes its toll, but he's a gritty little horse. I will say one thing...after the Belmont Stakes, he gets a long rest."

CASH WEIGHS IN Cash Asmussen has been booked to ride the well-regarded **Weigh Anchor** (Slip Anchor) in the June 1 Epsom Derby. The colt's trainer Ian Balding said, "We went for Cash because Epsom is not an easy track to ride, but he is a top-class international jockey and has enough experience of the course." Meanwhile, 58-year-old Lester Piggott, looking for his 10th Derby success next Wed., has accepted the mount on **Khamaseen** (Slip Anchor). Other leading contenders are **Erhaab** (Chief's Crown), **Broadway Flyer** (Theatrical {IRE}), **Colonel Collins** (El Gran Senor), **Linney Head** (Lyphard), **Foyer** (Sadler's Wells) and **Sunshack** (Rainbow Quest).

HOLLYWOOD TURF H.-GI, \$500,000, 3yo/up, 10fT GI winning millionaires **Bien Bien** (Manila) and **Arcangues** (Sagace {FR}) have been assigned co-highweight of 124 pounds for the Memorial Day event. Richard Mandella, trainer of Breeders' Cup Classic winner Arcangues, expressed disappointment in the weights. "I think it's somewhat unfair, because he doesn't have the record on the grass that Bien Bien's got," said Mandella. "He won one Group 1 race in Europe on grass. Physically, he's doing fine. As far as running, I'll think about the weights." In all, 13 horses were weighted by Hollywood Park Racing Secretary and Handicapper Martin Panza. Following the top pair are **Slew of Damascus** (Slewacide), 120; **Misil** (Miswaki), 119; **Navarone** (Irish River {FR}) and **Mashaallah** (Nijinsky II), 118; **Grand Flotilla** (Caro {IRE}) and **Stuka** (Jade Hunter), 116; **Blues Traveller** (IRE) (Bluebird), **The Tender Track** (Topsider), **Square Cut** (Assert {IRE}) and **Sir Mark Sikes**, all 114; **Kazabaiyn** (Shahrastani), 112.

HAWTHORNE H.-GII, \$100,000a, 3yo/up, f/m, 8.5f Irving and Marjorie Cowan's 1993 Eclipse Award-winning three-year-old filly **Hollywood Wildcat** (Kris S.) worked seven furlongs in a bullet 1:24 4/5 Sun. morning at Hollywood Park, prompting trainer Neil Drysdale to pronounce her as a starter in the Hawthorne. Hollywood Wildcat, winner of last year's GI BC Distaff, hasn't raced since finishing a distant third in the La Canada S. Feb. 5 and was subsequently knocked out of action after developing a cough. Confirmed starters for the Hawthorne include Hollywood Wildcat (Kris S.), Delahoussaye; **Andestine** (Native Prospector), McCarron; **Likeable Style** (Nijinsky II), Stevens; **Aube Indienne** (FR) (Bluebird), no rider; **Lunar Spook** (Silver Ghost), Pincay Jr.; **Potridee** (ARG) (Potrillazo {ARG}), Solis.

FASIG-TIPTON MIDLANTIC SALE POSTS

GAINS Fasig-Tipton Midlantic held its Spring Selected and Open Two-Year-Olds in Training and Horses of Racing Age Sale Mon. in Timonium, Maryland. In the selected session, 70 two-year-olds were sold for a gross of \$1,357,500 and an average of \$19,393, up 29.8% from the 1993 average of \$14,935. The sales topper was a bay filly by Allen's Prospect--Fuel to Burn (Northern Native). The filly, a half-sister to MSW Flaming Emperor (Hail Emperor), was purchased by Rainbow Stables for \$80,000. In the open two-year-olds and horses of racing age session, 64 horses were sold for a total of \$529,300 and an average of \$8,270, a 51.5 percent increase over last year's figure of \$5,457.
