CHRB ISSUES COMPLAINTS The California Horse Racing Board has issued complaints for post-race scopolamine positives against three trainers. Forum Club, trained by Bill Shoemaker; Wildly Joyous, trained by Richard Mandella; and Unpredictable Gal, trained by Lewis Cenicola were all tested positive for the substance during the first eight days of April. The CHRB issued a bulletin April 21, advising horsemen of the presence of scopolamine in straw which had been delivered to tracks in Southern California.

STAR OF COZZENE RETURNS TODAY Tomaeata Farm's **Star of Cozzene** (Cozzene) is scheduled to return to action in the fourth race at Hollywood this afternoon, a \$55,000 allowance event at a mile and a sixteenth on the grass. Trainer Mark Hennig said he didn't alert anyone to the six-year-old's comeback because he was "worried that the race wouldn't fill." A winner of 14 of his 34 starts, the GI winner has bankrolled \$2,242,650; plans this year call for a try for his second straight Arlington Million.

DERBY "HERO" IN BELMONT TURF TEST
MONDAY Last year's Kentucky Derby and Travers winner **Sea Hero** (Polish Navy) makes his second start of the year, returning to the turf for a \$44,000 allowance test at Belmont Monday. Away since finishing third in the Molson Million last September, the Rokeby colt came back at four to take his seasonal bow by 1 1/4 going seven furlongs on the dirt; he faces eight rivals, including graded stakes winners **Roman Envoy** (Roman Diplomat), **Fourstars Allstar** (Compliance), **Solar Splendor** (Majestic Light), **Binary Light** (Bionic Light) and **Fourstardave** (Compliance), in his first grass race since Feb. '93. All starters carry 119 pounds.

"This is very tough--but he must be tough, too. At least the handicapper seems to think so," said trainer Scotty Schulhofer of his Met Mile runner, highweight **Colonial Affair** (Pleasant Colony). Last year's Belmont Stakes winner comes into the race off a win in the Excelsior H. The Hall of Fame horseman added, "He was a big kid last year and he's grown into a man." **Holy Bull** (Great Above) will test his elders as the lone three-year-old in the field. "In both of his bad races (Fountain of Youth and Kentucky Derby), I think he had legitimate excuses," said owner/trainer Jimmy Croll. "In fact, I know he had excuses, and he has bounced back real well."
