HOLLYWOOD WILDCAT SCRATCHED Last year's champion three-year-old filly **Hollywood Wildcat** (Kris S.) was scratched from yesterday's GII Hawthorne H. after she developed a cough. "It's very minor, but she coughed a little bit Friday and a little bit Saturday. It's strictly precautionary. She'll be all right in a few days," said her trainer, Neil Drysdale. The GISW is expected to make her next start in the \$150,000 Milady H. at Hollywood June 26.

BELMONT RUNNERS BREEZE Two of the top contenders for the last leg of the Triple Crown worked over the Belmont main track Sunday morning. Derby runner-up **Strodes Creek** (Halo) went seven furlongs in 1:28.47, while Santa Anita Derby winner **Brocco** (Kris S.) went the same distance in 1:23.64. "He went fine," said Strodes Creek's trainer, Charlie Whittingham. "He's a lazy work horse--there's nothing you can do about that. He's just not a good work horse unless he has company." Trainer Randy Winick said of his Belmont runner, Brocco, "He really seems to like the racetrack here. He's worked twice and both times they were good works." Both colts skipped the Preakness to await the Belmont S.

THE WICKED NORTH PREPS FOR CALIFORNIAN The **Wicked North** (Far North), ranked number one in the Thoroughbred Racing Communications poll and early favorite for next Sunday's \$300,000 Californian H. at Hollywood, worked five-eighths in :59 1/5 yesterday in preparation for the race. "It was a great work--he galloped out super," said trainer David Bernstein. "Now it's just a matter of waiting for the race." Jockey Kent Desormeaux was aboard for the move, and owner Philip Hersh was on hand to watch. "He's something else," said Hersh. "He never runs a bad race, and we have no reason to think he's going to--but that's horse racing. You never take winning for granted."

Thoro-Graph Analysis by Jerry Brown

For owners and trainers, "The Race" may be the Derby, but for horseplayers it has to be the Met Mile--always the most interesting, complicated, competitive race of the year. Where else do you get to analyze three-year-olds versus older horses; sprinters versus routers; and the equalizing effects of weight--all over a one-turn mile that virtually eliminates racing luck? It would not be a big surprise if one of six or seven horses won this race, and certainly if **Holy Bull** (Great Above) runs his race, getting an easy trip and a big weight pull, he could win off--but the value in the race is clearly **West by West** (Gone West). It was at this time last year that West by West got real good, putting in huge figures back to back in May and June. His graph pattern this year says he's ready to do it again, and at the weights his best is very strong. Thoro-Graph Analysis by Jerry Brown

The whole world seems to have decided that Hollywood's grassy Grade I is a match race between **Bien Bien** (Manila) and **Arcangues** (Sagace), and those two certainly are fine performers. But this is a handicap, and we are basically contrary, so...

The first thing to remember is that five pounds of weight equals two full lengths at this distance, and the two highweights are giving that much or more to every member of this field. Additionally, while Arcangues' last two figures are huge, he has never put two big ones together with less than five months between them--and he just ran a big one a month ago. Bien Bien is much more solid, but not quite as good on his best.

Which brings us to **Misil** (Miswaki), who ran successfully last year as the highweight against some of the best grass horses in the world. In his only American grass try, he ran a big figure despite trouble. He may have even better races in him, and with a big pull in the weights, may not even need to run better.
