FORMER FASIG-TIPTON HEAD DIES John Finney, former chairman and president of the Fasig-Tipton sales firm and one of the best-known people in the world of Thoroughbred auctions, died at the University of Kentucky Medical Center in Lexington yesterday morning. Finney, who would have been 60 June 4, had been hospitalized since May 7. He underwent heart transplant surgery last October. After resigning from Fasig-Tipton in Jan. of 1989, Finney operated Finney Bloodstock, a Lexington-based bloodstock agency and Thoroughbred advisory firm founded in partnership with his son, Michael Finney. Finney Bloodstock ranked as the third-leading American buyer of auction yearlings in 1992. A funeral service will be conducted Sat. at St. Raphael's Episcopal Church in Lexington.

Paco Gonzalez sent GII Mervyn Leroy H. winner **Del Mar Dennis** (Dixieland Band) five furlongs Tues. in 1:00 2/5 and said the workout went very well.

BIEN BIEN MAY BE HEADED EAST Trainer Paco Gonzalez reported Trudy McCaffery and John Toffan's **Bien Bien** (Manila), second as the 4-5 favorite in Mon.'s GI Hollywood Turf H., might be shipped to Atlantic City, N.J. for the GI \$500,000 Caesars International H. at 1 3/16 miles on the turf June 26. "He's doing good," said Gonzalez. "We're not sure he's going to Atlantic City, but there's a good chance."

ATLANTIC CITY OPENS TODAY Atlantic City Race Course near Atlantic City, N.J. opens its 1994 season today. The meeting, which ends Sept. 3, will feature twilight racing for the first time, to be held Mondays at 3 p.m. The track will be dark Sundays and Wednesdays.

ARCANGUES A BIT STIFF AFTER TURF HANDICAP Wildenstein Stable's **Arcangues** (Sagace {FR}), who has a history of back soreness, came out of Mon.'s Hollywood Turf H. with a bit of stiffness, according to trainer Richard Mandella. Arcangues tired in the stretch and finished fifth as the 5-2 second choice. "Basically, he came out of the race all right," said Mandella. "But he is a little bit stiff, and we'll watch him closely for a few days." Mandella added that the 1993 BC Classic winner is still a possible starter in the \$750,000 Hollywood Gold Cup, to be run July 2.
