HOLY BULL TO SKIP BELMONT Trainer Jimmy Croll has decided to skip the June 11 Belmont S. with GI Metropolitan Mile winner **Holy Bull** (Great Above) and instead point the colt for the July 3 Dwyer S., to be run over 1 1/8 miles at Belmont. It is expected that Holy Bull will meet **Twining** (Forty Niner), the undefeated winner of the GII Peter Pan. "I just think that it is best for the horse," said Croll. "He needs more time. He comes first and I have to do what is best for him."

CALDER UP IN ATTENDANCE, HANDLE

Calder Race Course in Miami posted gains in on-track attendance, on-track handle and total money wagered for its first week of racing. Through the first six days of the meeting (including Memorial Day and the holiday weekend), 48,811 fans visited Calder for a daily average of 8,135--up 38 percent from the 35,443 (5,907 average) that visited last year during a comparable six-day time period. On-track, fans wagered just over \$5.8 million for a daily average of \$970,370--up almost \$1 million (or over \$150,000 daily) from 1993. And through Memorial Day, over \$10.2 million (\$1.7 million daily) had been wagered on Calder races by patrons at out-of-state locations, intertrack sites and at Calder itself--up almost \$200,000 a day over last year's total handle.
