EASY GOER'S FIRST Easy Goer, who died May 12 at Claiborne Farm of anaphylactic shock, will have his first starter as a sire today at Churchill Downs. His two-year-old daughter **Summer Home**, out of the MGI-winning Fappiano mare Tappiano, is scheduled to become the champion's first runner. Summer Home, purchased by Seth Hancock, agent, for \$450,000 at the 1993 Keeneland July yearling sale, is trained by Steven Penrod. She is entered in today's seventh race at the Louisville track, a five-furlong maiden special weight, and has drawn the outside post in a field of 12 juvenile fillies.

DISAGREEMENT OVER EPSOM DERBY FIELDS British racing professionals are divided about calls to restrict the size of future Epsom Derby fields. Wed.'s Classic-winning jockey Willie Carson made a post-race plea for a reduction in the current safety limit of 33 after fellow rider Willie Ryan broke three ribs in a fall caused by bunching on Epsom's steep Tattenham Hill. But several trainers who saddled outsiders in the G1 event have expressed strong opposition to his opinion. Ryan himself said he was not in favor of limiting the field by a process of handicappers' elimination, but went on to admit: "There were a lot of no-hopers and it was a very rough race. My horse (Foyer) simply ran out of room. He nose-dived and I shot out of the saddle."

STRODES CREEK IN BELMONT BREEZE Derby runner-up **Strodes Creek** (Halo) worked a mile in 1:40.34, breezing, at Belmont with jockey Jerry Bailey aboard yesterday morning in preparation for next Saturday's Belmont S. The colt will blow out for the race next week. Derby winner **Go for Gin** (Cormorant) is scheduled to work six furlongs and **Brocco** (Kris S.) will go seven-eighths or a mile this morning.
