The field for Hollywood's major prep for the Gold Cup this year is comprised mostly of hard-hitting types, and there is wagering value to be found here. **The Wicked North** (Far North) has emerged as the marquee name of the division, but as his highweight assignments creep up, his figures become less formidable--he's a contender, but beatable. **Hill Pass** (Temperence Hill) has quietly developed into a pretty nice horse, and as the lightweight he may very well go off as the biggest price in the field. The way this race sets up, he should be able to sit behind the battle on the front end and make one run, and he's clearly the value. *Thoro-Graph sheets, state-of-the-art performance figures, are used by many horsemen and professional handicappers to evaluate the ability of racehorses.
