## GUINEAS WINNERS CLASH AT ASCOT

Two Thousand Guineas winners from three countries are set to clash in next Tues.'s St. James's Palace at Royal Ascot. The G1 event, already being billed as Europe's one mile championship for three-year-olds, will bring together **Green Tune** (Green Dancer), successful in the French 2000 Guineas, **Royal Abjar** (Gone West), the German 2000 hero, and **Turtle Island (IRE)** (Fairy King), victorious in the Irish 2000. **Grand Lodge** (Chief's Crown), a short-head runner-up to Mr. Baileys in the Newmarket 2000, is also expected to be in the field.

## DETTORI TAKES HONG KONG ROUTE

Frankie Dettori, who was refused a license to ride in Hong Kong last year after receiving a police caution for a drugs-related offense, has snapped up a second chance to ride there. The 23-year-old, currently heading the jockeys' table in Britain, has accepted an offer which would take him to the Far East from mid-November.
