### VELASQUEZ TO TAKE A BREAK FROM

**RIDING** Hall of Fame jockey Jorge Velasquez, who took a bad spill in Feb. but recently returned to riding at the opening of Calder May 25, announced Thurs. that he would take a break for an unspecified period in order to continue therapy and get stronger for another comeback. "The doctors said it would take me four to six months to come back after I got hurt, but I'm a competitive athlete and I tried to come back in three months," said the 47-year-old Panamanian riding star, who broke his pelvis and suffered hairline fractures in his neck after a spill during training hours at Calder Feb. 3. "I have no thought whatsoever of retiring. I'm going to win 7,000 races before I consider retiring." Through Mon., Velasquez' career line was 6,627 winners from 39,216 mounts with earnings of more than \$122 million.

### SIMULCASTING PLANS ANNOUNCED FROM SAM HOUSTON

Full-card simulcasting will be in full force on a regular basis once the inaugural Thoroughbred meeting is concluded at Sam Houston June 19. Beginning Mon., June 20, the track will begin bringing in as many as six simulcast signals on designated days. The simulcast racing will be conducted on a seven-day-a-week schedule.

### FLORIDA LEGISLATURE OKAYS DRUG

**STUDY** The Florida Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering Laboratory and the University of Florida school of Veterinary Medicine have received \$1,396,530 from the state legislature for a three-year-study aimed at establishing elimination times for a variety of therapeutic drugs. Additionally, the study will compare the elimination and withdrawal times of the drugs and the physiological effects of each drug.

### JEFF LUKAS VISITS HOLLYWOOD PARK

Trainer Jeff Lukas visited Hollywood Park Wed. for the first time since his near fatal accident in the Santa Anita stable area late last year. Lukas said the tentative plan calls for him to resume working at his father D. Wayne Lukas's Santa Anita-based stable Mon., June 27. To begin, Lukas said he will work some five hours a day and gradually work up to full speed. "I'll watch horses train, make out work charts and do the basics," he said.

"You hate to back off with so many good races coming up, but he had an ankle problem that needed attention. Stopping on him seemed to take care of the problem--he's pretty fit now." Added his regular rider, Pat Day, "He's a horse that always had a lot of talent, but last year I don't think he had enough chance to show it. He was over-aggressive--an overachiever, you might say. This year, he has developed into a push-button horse. It makes him a formidable opponent."
