BROCCO SCRATCHED FROM

BELMONT STAKES

Santa Anita Derby winner Brocco (Kris S.) was scratched from yesterday's Belmont S. due to a stone bruise in his right front foot. "It didn't show up until the day after his work. It's in the best interests of the horse not to run him. If the race was three to five days later, we'd have had no problem," said his trainer, Randy Winick. "He's not lame, he's just tender. I feel very bad for the owners. They have invested a lot of time and money coming here and they won't be able to see their horse run. We'll be back here later in the year." The colt is scheduled to ship back to California Tuesday.

JOCKEY CLUB EXPANDS DNA-TYPING

PROGRAM The Jockey Club began mailing blood kits to breeders of the 1994 Thoroughbred foal crop this week; simultaneously it announced that DNA sampling kits would be mailed to owners of selected mares under the age of 15 in the next phase of the program to implement a DNA-based test in replacement of blood-typing for parentage verification. DNA-typing will become a requirement for all stallions which have covered mares during the current '94 breeding season. Barring any unforeseen setback, DNA-based verification would be a requirement of The American Stud Book for the foal crop of 1995. During the phase-in period, 50 percent of the fee to DNA-type breeding stock already blood-typed will be subsidized by The Jockey Club, which estimates that, on average, DNA parentage verification will save breeders more than \$30 for every foal registered, effectively removing more than \$1 million from overall annual breeding costs.

SUNDAY RACING POPULAR WITH BRITISH

COURSES Competition is fierce among racecourses hoping to stage Sunday fixtures in Britain next year. A total of 24 meetings, on 12 Sundays, are expected to be given the go-ahead following a change in gambling laws enabling on and off-course Sunday betting. So far, 40 of Britain's 59 courses have applied, including Classic venues Doncaster, Epsom and Newmarket.

Preakness winner Tabasco Cat, carried wide around the first turn by frontrunning Derby winner Go for Gin, settled just off the pace to the top of the stretch, then drew even with that rival and outgamed him down the lane to give jockey Pat Day his second Grade I win of the afternoon. "I'd like to play the first Saturday in May over again on a dry track, with all the horses getting different trips," said trainer D. Wayne Lukas, winning his first Belmont in his eighth try. "But you only get one chance at these races." Jockey Pat Day commented on the race, "It shaped up a lot like the Preakness, with us sitting right behind the pace. He's a push-button horse--at the three-eighths pole I just nudged him and he got to running. I wouldn't want to say this horse is an Easy Goer (who won the '89 Belmont with Day aboard) yet, but he's a quality colt and he's going to be around for awhile." As for the future, Lukas said, "I'd say, off the top of my head, we'll have to take a strong look at the Travers. I think this horse is every bit as good and sound as when we just started."

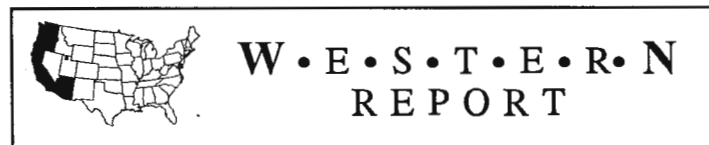
