**BELMONT STAKES WRAP-UP** "He's very, very good," said assistant trainer Todd Pletcher of Belmont S. winner **Tabasco Cat** (Storm Cat). "He's leaving on Tuesday to go, I believe, to California." Runner-up **Go for Gin** (Cormorant) also came out of the race in good order. "He came out of the race good. Now it's break time," said his trainer, Nick Zito. "He'll certainly get two weeks off. I'd love to win a race called the Travers with him, but I just can't do it to the horse. It's not fair, he's been campaigning all year. I'm going to stick to my plan. We'll look at either the King's Bishop at Saratoga Travers Day going seven-eighths, or get a handicap race for him. I want to get him ready for the Woodward."

**LAUREL OPENS TUESDAY** Laurel Race Course will celebrate Tuesday's opening day of the Summer Meet with a "Three For All" special and a 10-race card, highlighted by the \$35,000 Bold Queen S. on the turf. Post time is set for 1:05 p.m. EDT. All patrons Tuesday will be treated to free admission, a free program and a free "Live It Up at Laurel" coupon book valued at over \$50, containing admission and program passes as well as concession and gift shop discounts. The 31-day Summer Meet will feature a stakes schedule worth \$1,030,000, topped by the six-furlong GII \$300,000 Frank J. De Francis Memorial Dash July 16. The meeting runs through July 24.

**ARCANGUES DRILLS FOR GOLD CUP** The '93 Breeders' Cup Classic winner **Arcangues** (Sagace), fifth in the Hollywood Turf H. last out after winning the GII John Henry H. in his seasonal bow, went a half-mile in :49 4/5 at Hollywood Sunday as he prepares for the \$750,000 Hollywood Gold Cup July 2.
