BROCCO POINTS TO SWAPS STAKES Albert and Dana Broccoli's **Brocco** (Kris S.), who missed the 126th edition of the Belmont S. Sat. due to a bruised right front foot, will make his next start at Hollywood Park in the July 23 Swaps S. "It would never have been in our game plan if he hadn't missed the Preakness and the Belmont," said trainer Randy Winick from his Santa Anita headquarters Wed. morning. "But if he's ever going to get ready for the fall, he needs that race."

NO SUNDAY DERBY IN 1995 Next year's Epsom Derby will not be run on a Sunday, but there will be major alterations to the traditional four-day Epsom meeting in 1995. New proposals from racecourse executives suggest that a Saturday Derby is now the favorite option, with the Oaks and Coronation Cup being run on the previous afternoon in a meeting covering just three days.

LAKEWAY TO RUN IN OAKS, BUT WHICH ONE? Michael Rutherford's **Lakeway** (Seattle Slew), who turned in a brilliant performance while defeating odds-on **Inside Information** (Private Account) in the GI Mother Goose Sun. at Belmont, has returned to trainer Gary Jones' Hollywood Park shedrow. Jones said the filly will go next in either the GI Hollywood Oaks July 10 at Hollywood or the GI Coaching Club American Oaks July 9 at Belmont. "I'm leaning toward running her here (in the Hollywood Oaks)," said Jones. "But that will be Mr. Rutherford's decision."

NATIONAL MUSEUM OF RACING TO OFFER TOURS Starting June 18, the National Museum of Racing and Hall of Fame in Saratoga Springs, NY will offer walking tours of the nearby Oklahoma Training Center at Saratoga Race Course. Two separate tours will be offered on Wednesdays, Fridays and Saturdays: the two-hour Walking Tour of the Training Track and the hour-long Grooming Demonstration.

Kissing Cousin, who was the subject of a massive gamble which drove her odds down from 16-1 to 13-2, was the fourth winner at the meeting for Irish champion jockey Michael Kinane.

HEMPSTEAD H.-GI, \$150,000, 3yo/up, f/m, 9f
Trainer Allen Jerkens is confident about the chances of **Sky Beauty** (Blushing Groom {FR}) in the Hempstead, but is also concerned about the 128 pounds she'll have to carry. "We are giving away a lot of weight," said Jerkens. "There are a couple of fresh fillies with a lot of ability and who I have a lot of respect for." **You'd Be Surprised** (Blushing Groom {FR}), trained by Mack Miller, is undefeated in two allowance starts this year and has been assigned 118 pounds. Miller's assistant, Danny Furr, believes that Sky Beauty can be defeated. "Weight was the biggest factor in our decision to run her," said Furr. "Sky Beauty will pick up a couple of pounds. You'd Be Surprised has been working real well. She blew out a good 7/8-mile the other day." You'd Be Surprised is scheduled to work a 1/2-mile Friday. **Better as a Memory** (Gone West), **Dance for Donna** (Apalachee) and **Schway Baby Sway** (Evzone) are also possible for the race.
