NEAR TRAGEDY AT ASCOT A 21-year-old spectator rushed onto the track during the G2 Ribblesdale S. at Royal Ascot in England yesterday, running in front of Sheikh Mohammed al Maktoum's **Papago (IRE)** (Sadler's Wells), who was near last at the time. The filly was brought down by the spectator; she and her rider, Michael Kinane, were unscathed, but the unnamed spectator was rushed to the hospital with multiple serious injuries. "I don't think he realized we were coming," said Kinane. "He must be in a bad way; we hit him with full force." Police said the incident was an accident; no special interest groups were involved. The young man had been drinking on the infield with friends all afternoon, and apparently ducked under the running rail and attempted to cross the course at the one-furlong letter on a dare; he did not see the two horses trailing the field. The collision occurred before 72,000 people, the biggest crowd of the week at Royal Ascot, and took place directly in front of the Royal Box, where the Queen was in attendance. The spectator, from Bracknell, is currently listed in stable condition.

LAUREL CANCELS RACING AFTER SIXTH

A severe rain and lightening storm forced the cancellation of racing after the sixth event Thurs. afternoon at Laurel Race Course in Maryland. "We experienced a long delay due to torrential rains and an excessive period of lightening strikes," said Laurel Senior VP and General Manager John Mooney. "During the delay, lightening struck and split a flagpole in the track's infield and also struck a transformer, which provides service to the tote board. Due to the excessive delay and not knowing the effects on the (pari-mutuel) systems, we made the determination to cancel racing." No injuries, human or equine, were reported. The tote and related wagering systems were not damaged; refunds were promptly issued to all patrons. Laurel continued to offer simulcast wagering Thurs. evening, and live racing is scheduled to resume today.

CARRYOVERS HEADLINE NATIONAL BEST

SEVEN This Sat.'s National Best Seven pools will start with over \$149,996 in carryovers, as no one correctly selected all seven winners in last week's event. A carryover of \$106,819.11 will be divided among those successfully selecting all seven winners, and the Jackpot Pool, an additional award if there is only one winning ticket in the nation, will be \$43,177.10. This week's National Best Seven will include races from California and Texas for the first time. In addition, Sam Houston Race Course has received the necessary approvals from the Texas HBPA and the Texas Racing Commission and will be the first outlet in Texas to offer the National Best Seven this Sat. This week's races include the Princess S. (Hollywood), Maxxam Gold Cup (Sam Houston), Brooklyn H. (Belmont), Ohio Derby (Thistledown), Swoon's Son H. (Arlington), Honeymoon S. (Louisiana Downs) and Chieftain H. (Pimlico).

MARES IN FOAL WIN BACK-TO-BACK

RACES AT HOLLYWOOD Wednesday at Hollywood Park, 11-1 shot **Miss High Blade** (Highland Blade), in foal to **Houston** (Seattle Slew), took the \$60,000 Estrapade S. right after **Splendid Dream** (Bel Bolide) won the seventh race, a \$25,000 claimer, for leading trainer Sandy Shulman. Trainer Mike Mitchell said Miss High Blade was bred three times at Lanes End Farm in Kentucky. "She was in training all the time we were breeding her," said Mitchell. "I would guess she's about two months in foal, and she'll probably drop her foal at Cardiff, which would make it a California-bred." Shulman said Splendid Dream is in foal to **Native Prospector** (Mr. Prospector), and he plans to race her again in a few weeks.

VETERINARIANS "HEALTHLINE" INITIATED

The American Association of Equine Practitioners and the Grayson-Jockey Club Research Foundation have joined to initiate "Healthline," a referral line for veterinarians only that can direct them to veterinary specialists who have access to the most current information.
