GUINEAS ON A SUNDAY Next year's British 1,000 Guineas will be run on a Sunday if the Newmarket Racecourse has its way. Track officials have proposed a three-day fixture, opening on a Friday, in 1995. The 2,000 Guineas would retain its usual Saturday spot. The idea will now be put before the British Horse Racing Board; Newmarket spokesman Nick Lees said, "If the plan is accepted, the 1,000 Guineas would be the first G1 race to be staged in Britain on a Sunday. I'm very hopeful it would be a great success."

ASCOT RACEGOER "SITTING UP" The Royal Ascot racegoer knocked down when he ran out in front of Thursday's Ribblesdale S. field is reported to be "sitting up and talking to staff" from his bed in Wexham Park Hospital in England. The man, 21-year-old Jimmy Florey, climbed a chain-link fence before ducking under the rails and colliding with Papago (IRE), owned by Sheikh Mohammed. Eyewitnesses said he had been drinking and Thames Valley Police, who are investigating the incident, are treating it as an "accident." Nevertheless, Ascot is planning its own inquiry into the possible security implications at a fixture attended by all members of the Royal family.

Thoro-Graph Analysis

The procession of excellent three-year-old racing continues with this week's Ohio Derby, and shows no signs of abating. **Concern** (Broad Brush) will be favored off his strong efforts in Hot Springs and Baltimore, but those two efforts were dramatic improvements from his prior form. As we have pointed out in this space, spring three-year-olds often pair up big efforts, then bounce. We expect that to happen with Concern.

We admit to having more than a rooting interest in **Kandaly** (Alydar), as we recommended his purchase after his third lifetime start. Our client was rewarded with a quick return in the Louisiana Derby, and Kandaly has continued to show nice, steady improvement. His last, fourth in the Preakness, was his best yet, and we expect a repeat of that performance in Cleveland.

While our hearts (and bank account) ride with **Kandaly**, our heads say **Smilin Singing Sam** (Smile). After a huge performance in the Remington Park Derby, he bounced in Louisville. Now, with plenty of rest, he should fire his best shot. Drawn inside with controlling speed, that should be good enough. The play: **Smilin Singin Sam** to win, and an exacta box with **Kandaly**. *Thoro-Graph sheets, state-of-the-art performance figures, are used by many horsemen and professional handicappers to evaluate the ability of racehorses.
