CAESAR'S INTERNATIONAL FEATURED ON CBS The GI \$500,000 Caesar's International H. at Atlantic City Race Course will be the centerpiece for a two-hour telecast on CBS next Sunday. Scheduled to air from 2-4:00 p.m. EDT, the show will include live coverage of the Caesar's, post time 3:40 p.m., as well as two additional stakes-- the Gill \$100,000 Jersey Shore Budweiser Breeders' Cup from Atlantic City, post time 3:03 p.m., and the Gill \$100,000 Reeve Schley Jr. S. from Monmouth Park, post time 3:15 p.m. A 10-round Junior Featherweight bout between Kevin Kelley and George "Go Go" Navarro, which will take place in a ring trackside at Atlantic City, will lead off the telecast. Commentators and analysts for the program include Derby winning trainer Nick Zito, Tim Ryan, Gil Clancy and Hank Goldberg. Last year's winner and runner-up in the Caesar's, **Star of Cozzene** (Cozzene) and **Lure** (Danzig), are expected for a rematch in this year's race.

THE WICKED NORTH PREPS FOR GOLD CUP The **Wicked North** (Far North), rated No. 1 in the Thoroughbred Racing Communications poll, breezed five furlongs at Hollywood Saturday, getting the distance in 1:03 4/5 with jockey Kent Desormeaux up. The five-year-old will make his next start in the GI \$750,000 Hollywood Gold Cup July 2. "He breezed a little slower than I wanted," said his trainer, David Bernstein. "But he came out of it good and that's the main thing. He's raced all over this year and he's fit enough right now."

TABASCO CAT ON "R AND R" Preakness and Belmont S. winner **Tabasco Cat** (Storm Cat) is enjoying a well-deserved vacation on trainer D. Wayne Lukas' Westerly Ranch in Santa Ynez, California. The colt will reportedly have 10 days on the farm before returning to the Lukas barn at Santa Anita to prepare for a late summer/fall campaign.
