WITH APPROVAL SIRES FIRST WINNER

Freshman sire **With Approval** (Caro {IRE}) was represented by his first winner when the two-year-old filly **Scattered Dreams** broke her maiden in her first start June 11 at Northlands Park. Scattered Dreams is out of Canadian multiple stakes winner Tarage and was bred by Kinghaven Farms, which raced With Approval. Scattered Dreams was sold by Kinghaven-owned Anderson Farms for \$75,000 at the 1994 Keeneland January Sale. In 1989, With Approval became the first horse in 25 years to win the Canadian Triple Crown and was named Champion Three-Year-Old Colt and Horse of the Year in Canada. He stands at Live Oak Stud in Ocala, Florida.

RACES TO BE SHOWN IN ASIA Australia's richest man and most celebrated gambler, Kerry Packer, has been authorized to beam his country's top horse races into Asia, the United States and Latin America. Sky Channel Pty, part of Packer's media empire, has reached an agreement with the Australian Jockey Club for the overseas telecast rights of Australia's major horse races. Under the Overseas Telecasting Marketing Agreement, signed Friday, Australian races will be beamed by satellite into the U.S. July 2 and to Central and South America and Asia before the end of the year. Sky, a subsidiary of Packer's Nine Network Australia Ltd., beat off a late challenge from Rupert Murdoch's Hong Kong-based Asian satellite broadcaster STAR TV to secure the deal.

The Ben Perkins-trained and New Farm-owned entry of **Whirl's Girl** (Island Whirl) and **Pent Up Kiss** (Pentelicus) is the morning-line favorite. The two fillies are coming up to the race off similar schedules, having broken their maidens first time out at Belmont June 9 and having worked a bullet four furlongs in :48 2/5 in company at Monmouth Sunday. Carrying highweight of 118 pounds is **Traces Of Gold** (Strike Gold), the only stakes-winner in the field, who ships in from Texas after taking the Calamity Jane S. over a sloppy Sam Houston track May 15.

REEVE SCHLEY JR. S.-GII, \$100,000, 3yo, f, 8f 70yds Trainer Bud Delp, who will saddle **Calipha** (Two Punch), knows he's found some formidable opposition for his budding star. "**Two Altazano** (Manzotti), that's who I've got to beat," said Delp. "She's got speed and so do I, but my filly's training really well." Calipha goes into the event carrying a four-race win streak, including a victory in the GII Black-Eyed Susan in her last outing. "She breezed a nice seven furlongs in 1:27 three days ago," said Delp yesterday. "She wasn't all out at all. She did it very easily." The Mike Stidham-trained **Two Altazano** also enters with an impressive resume, including three stakes wins in her last three starts. Other probables are GI winner **Strategic Maneuver** (Cryptoclearance), **Facts of Love** (Known Fact), **Our Royal Blue** (Our Native), **Bunting** (Private Account), **Accountinquestion** (Classic Account), **Seeking the Circle** (Seeking the Gold), **Golden Braids** (Forty Niner), **Love To Be Loved** (Hay Halo) and **Just a Little Kiss** (Mugatea).
