ADVERTISING BILL PASSES FOR NEW YORK JOCKEYS

The bill which will allow New York jockeys to wear corporate logos on their racing attire was signed into law by Governor Mario Cuomo Wednesday. New York's riders are the first in the country to be able to display endorsers' insignias. The only portion of the jockeys' clothing which is exempt from logo-stamping are the silks, which are the property of the horse's owner. According to Thursday's *Asbury Park Press*, jockeys will need written permission from the owners of the horses they are to ride before they will be allowed to display advertising, and a corporation sponsoring a race has the power to forbid a jockey from wearing the logo of a competitor.

SAM HOUSTON WRAP-UP

The numbers are in for the inaugural season at Sam Houston Race Park. Total on-track attendance for the 45-day meet was 338,781, for an average of 7,528. On-track handle came to \$26,435,751, with an additional \$10,623,123 wagered at off-track sites; total average handle was \$799,086. The leading trainer at the meet was Jim Gaston, with 23 winners; the top rider was Ricky Frazier with 46 wins; and the leading owner was Sharon Hild with 12 victories.

SILKS ADVERTISING STARTS IN BRITAIN

Beginning today in Great Britain, sponsors' brand names and logos will, for the first time, be allowed to appear on jockeys' silks. A plan to allow such advertising material was sanctioned this week by the British Horseracing Board, and is expected to generate money for horse owners. Said owner Robert Sangster, who is seeking sponsorship for individual horses in his string, "It will open up a major new source of income for the racing industry, which seems certain to give our sport a considerable financial boost."

STRODES CREEK RECOVERING FROM SURGERY

Trainer Charlie Whittingham said **Strodes Creek** (Halo), second in the Kentucky Derby and third in the Belmont S., is progressing after surgery for an undescended testicle. "The operation was Sunday," said Whittingham. "He was walked for two days afterwards and now he's back to the track."

HILL PRINCE S.-GIII, \$75,000a, 3yo, 8.5f
Presently (Affirmed), a full brother to two-time Eclipse-winning turf mare Flawlessly, will be making his second start on the turf. In his first grass attempt, he finished third in the GIII Saranac S. May 14 at Belmont. "In the Hill Prince, my horse will probably come from out of it, but it depends on how much speed is in the race," said Presently's trainer Allen Jerkens. "His regular rider Jean-Luc Samyn will ride him." Howie Teshher-trainee **Sonny's Bruno** (Queen City Lad), winner of the Count Fleet S. at Aqueduct earlier this year, will be making his turf debut. "I've been working him on the turf and he really seems to like it," said Teshher. "But I won't mind if we got some rain and they took the race off the turf." CANADA'S BREEDERS' STAKES TO BE RUN AT FORT ERIE

The Breeders' Stakes, the third gem in Canada's Triple Crown of Racing, has been switched from Woodbine's stakes schedule to Fort Erie's program. The 1 1/2-mile turf race, to be run Sun., Aug. 21, was to have been the inaugural event on Woodbine's all new 1 1/2-mile turf course. However, unforeseen delays have backed up construction of the "European-type" grass course. "Because of the delays, it was important to make a decision as soon as possible about moving the race to Fort Erie so that all concerned can make appropriate plans," said John Whitson, Vice-President of Racing at the Ontario Jockey Club. The Canadian Triple Crown kicks off at Woodbine Sunday, July 10 with the 135th running of The Queen's Plate.
