### CHRB APPROVES POST MORTEM FUNDING

The California Horse Racing Board Friday authorized the continuation of the Post Mortem Examination Program at the University of California, Davis, by approving \$150,000 for the program and the position of equine medical director in its 1994-95 budget. Initiated in 1990, the necropsy program is credited with saving the lives of 68 horses in the last eight months. "We've learned that stress fractures are related to 20 to 25 percent of the deaths (due to catastrophic injury) of racehorses. We've also determined that stress fractures show very minimal clinical signs. As a result, we are looking harder and we're diagnosing more stress fractures at the very early stages," said Dr. Susan Stover of the California Veterinary Diagnostic Laboratory System, which is under contract with the CHRB to examine all horses that die at racetracks and recognized training centers in the state. Dr. Alex Ardans, director of CVDLS, said that a nuclear scintigraphy unit was put into place last October at Santa Anita; the bone-scanning equipment has detected stress fractures in 68 horses since it was put into operation.
