WINNING COLORS'S FIRST WINNER Kentucky Derby winner Winning Colors's second foal, the two-year-old filly Minden Rose (Mr. Prospector), made a winning debut at Evry in France Wednesday. Owned by Sheikh Mohammed al Maktoum and trained by Andre Fabre, she was ridden by stable jockey Thierry Jarnet. Bred in Kentucky by Gainesway Thoroughbreds Ltd., she was sent off the favorite in the six-furlong Prix de Lunain and won by a 1/2-length. She earned 80,000 francs (\$14,790) for the win. Always close to the pace, Minden Rose raced greenly once she was asked to go, and her connections said they are certain that she will improve dramatically from this performance. Minden Rose's full sister, consigned by and bred by Gainesway, appears as Hip 257 in the Tuesday, July 19 evening session of the Keeneland July Selected yearling sale.

FTBOA SEEKS RULING The Florida Thoroughbred Breeders' and Owners' Association has asked for a ruling on what it feels is Gulfstream Park's underpayment of \$1.2 million in purse money for the 1994 meeting. The FTBOA has filed the request with the Florida Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering in Tallahassee. The group contends that Gulfstream underpaid the Florida Owner's Awards (FOA) by \$400,000 and overnight purses by \$800,000. The FOA purses are additional prizes given to owners of Florida-bred horses that win designated races. The FTBOA argues the money for FOA and overnight purses should be taken from the handle on all exotic wagers, while Gulfstream contends the money is only derived from trifecta, Bet-3 and Pick-Six wagers. The Division of Pari-mutuel Wagering is expected to rule within the next month.

GRAND PRIX WINNER TO U.S.? Millkom (Cyrano de Bergerac), winner of Sunday's Grand Prix de Paris, looks set to continue his career in America. Negotiations are underway to purchase a share in the three-year-old colt, owned by Jean-Claude Gour, and send him to the West Coast under the care of Bill Mott. "If this occurs," said Jean-Claude Rouget, the colt's trainer, "Millkom could be sent to California to start a preparation for the Breeders' Cup."

BEST SEVEN LINEUP SET FOR MONDAY

The jackpot pool, paid if only a single bettor selects all seven winners, begins this week with a carryover of \$76,619.

LAKE SUSPENDED; APPEALS New York trainer Bobby Lake was suspended for 90 days by the New York State Racing & Wagering Board due to the presence of furosemide (Lasix) in the post-race urine sample of Music Tower, who finished second in the 9th race at Aqueduct April 15, 1994. Lake has appealed the suspension and has been granted a stay.

JOCKEYS TO DONATE AD REVENUES

The New York jockey contingent announced today that 10% of the money derived from advertising on the racing attire would be donated to the Jockeys' Injuries Compensation Fund. Revenues to the fund are currently derived from owner participation. The bill allowing advertising on jockeys' apparel was signed into law by Governor Mario Cuomo Wednesday.

BERTRANDO WON'T MAKE BEL AIR Eddie Nahem, co-owner of '93 Breeders' Cup Classic runner-up Bertrando (Skywalker) said the horse would not make the July 17 Bel Air, slated as the target race for his return. "He worked this morning (Wednesday) in :47 3/5, but as far as the Bel Air, no can do," said Nahem.

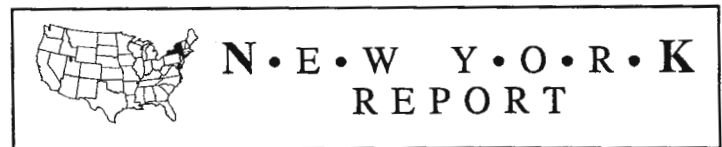

SUBURBAN H.-GI, \$350,000, 3yo/up, 10f
Trainer Gary Jones, who shipped Lakeway (Seattle Slew) to New York to win the June 12 Mother Goose, comes East again with **Kingdom Found** (The Bart). The California-bred four-year-old was second to The Wicked North (Far North) in the Grade I Californian in his last start June 5, and Jones opted to send the colt east to avoid another clash with that rival in Saturday's Hollywood Gold Cup. He is expected to meet **Devil His Due** (Devil's Bag), **Wallenda** (Gulch) and **Federal Funds** (Settlement Day) in the Suburban. "I think I have one horse to beat in New York," said Jones. "I don't envy trying to beat Mr. Jerkens, but I only get six pounds here against the Breeders' Cup Classic winner (Arcangues {Sagace}) and The Wicked North. "I get nine pounds there from Devil His Due."

HOLLYWOOD GOLD CUP H.-GI, \$750,000, 3/up, 10f
Del Mar Dennis (Dixieland Band) worked four furlongs in :47 3/5 under regular rider Sal Gonzalez Jr. in his final prep for the Gold Cup. "He's been working every five days and galloping a mile to a mile and a half on days when he doesn't work and he's still put on 10 pounds since (the Californian)," said trainer Paco Gonzalez. **Slew of Damascus** (Slewacide) worked five furlongs in 1:00 at Bay Meadows Tuesday morning, and was scheduled to ship to Hollywood yesterday. Gary Stevens picks up the mount. Other starters include **Fanmore** (Lear Fan), Corey Nakatani; **Arcangues** (Sagace), Jerry Bailey; and **The Wicked North** (Far North), Kent Desormeaux. The race will be televised on ESPN.
