Hoosier Park was denied its application for an OTB license in Merriville, Indiana, apparently based on the Commission's feeling that Sagamore Park was more deserving of that location due to its commitment to thoroughbred racing and its more substantial investment in Indiana racing. Jeffrey Smith, president of Anderson Park, Inc., owner of the Hoosier Park project, said, "Based upon statements made, we believe that members of the Indiana Horse Racing Commission were ill-informed." Hoosier Park officials are considering judicial intervention on the matter, and may ask the IHRC to reconsider its decision.

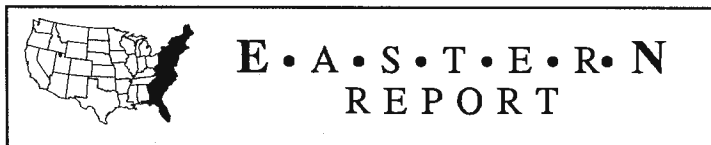
