NEW MANAGEMENT FOR WINTER RACING IN NEW YORK?

The impending passage of an omnibus racing bill in the New York Legislature could pave the way for private interests to temporarily take over the racing franchise this winter. The New York Racing Association has been asking for tax relief from the state after disastrous business conditions the past two winters. The bill now circulating offers NYRA some financial inducements to stay open this winter, but less than it had been seeking. NYRA estimates that it lost \$13 million last winter. The state is offering an \$8.5 million loan from the Capital Investment Fund plus a temporary minor cut in its share of the betting handle, which would go to NYRA. The latest legislation calls for NYRA to declare by July 15 whether it intends to conduct racing this winter. If NYRA decides not to operate, the franchise will be turned over to other interests with new management taking over from Oct. 18, 1994 to April 30, 1995. NYRA executives declined to comment yesterday. Al Fried Jr. of the New York Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association confirmed that he would try and put together a group to operate the track this winter on behalf of the horsemen, should NYRA decide not to run. In a related matter, the New York State Assembly issued a memorandum yesterday, declaring that the state would reduce its share of the handle with the difference going to purses, but did not specify amounts.

Allowed to set a snail's pace, Turk Passer, the longest shot on the board, had plenty left for the finish, drawing clear down the lane under jockey John Velazquez. "I took the lead without any challengers and I tried to slow the pace down," said the winning rider. "At the three-eighths pole, I started to pick up the pace. The rest was easy." Remarked trainer Tony Margotta, "This race was completely set up for my horse. I gave John special instructions to go to the lead and try to milk the pace because I didn't think there was that much speed...it was an absolutely superb ride." The winner will make his next start in the GI Sword Dancer at Saratoga. The 6-5 favorite Fraise ran third. "I thought we were in perfect position," said his trainer, Bill Mott. "He was only a length off the lead. He lost some ground on the turn--I don't think that a slow pace accounts for something like that. The weight was a factor. The only good part is that they'll have to drop him a few pounds; if there is any benefit to getting beat it is that."
