**NEW YORK RACING BILL PASSES** An omnibus racing bill was passed in both houses of the New York State Legislature early Sunday morning which will provide New York horsemen with a small purse increase and all but guarantees there will be winter racing in the state this year. The bill awaits the signature of Gov. Mario Cuomo, but he is expected to sign. The New York division of the Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association had been lobbying for a \$22 million annual increase in purses, the money coming through a reduction in the state's share of the total handle. The lawmakers rejected that request, but put together a package that will allow the New York Racing Association to raise purses by an estimated total of \$7.5 million for an eight-month period, beginning Aug. 1. "It's an effective 10 percent increase, and that's the biggest thing we've gotten in a long time," said Billy Abrams, secretary-treasurer of the New York HBPA. Other changes that will become law with Cuomo's signature include the addition of more simulcasting races to the OTB menu.

**HOLLYWOOD GOLD CUP WRAP-UP** The **Wicked North** (Far North), fourth as the odds-on favorite in Saturday's Hollywood Gold Cup, seemed okay Sunday morning after his unusual subpar effort. "He's a tired horse, but he walked fine," said trainer David Bernstein. "We really won't know for sure how he's doing for a couple of days. It may be that the races were just too close together for him." Trainer Richard Mandella is mystified by **Arcangues'** (Sagace {Fr}) last-place performance. "He looks about the same after this race as his other ones," he said. "He's a little stiff and sore, but that's normal for him. I don't know what to think." The winner, **Slew Of Damascus** (Slewacide) returned to his home base in Northern California Saturday night and will point for the Pacific Classic at Del Mar Aug. 13.
