CHURCHILL DOWNS POSTS RECORD

TOTALS Bolstered by major increases in handle fueled by a record 30 simulcast outlets outside of Kentucky, Churchill Downs closed its 120th spring meeting with across-the-board gains that reached record proportions in some areas despite the fact that the meet ran only 49 days as compared to 1993's 54 days. Average daily on-track handle of \$2,001,300 was up eight percent from last year, while total mutual handle from all sources came to \$210,631,516, a 29 percent increase. The largest gain was the 109 percent rise in national handle coming from the 30 outlets, including casinos in Las Vegas and New Jersey. "These numbers represent another exciting chapter in the continuing story of success at Churchill Downs," said Tom Meeker, President and CEO. "The distribution of our product continues to expand through simulcasting, which is an important component of our continuing success." Average daily on-track attendance of 14,894 represented a slight increase over 1993; total on-track attendance for the meeting was 729,782. The total purse disbursement for the meeting was \$11,090,000, the highest purse structure in Churchill Downs' history.

THREE SET FOR HOLLYWOOD OAKS The \$200,000a Hollywood Oaks July 10 has drawn three definite starters, but even connections of the third horse seem to concede match-race status to the event. The race will feature a rematch between **Lakeway** (Seattle Slew), winner of the GI Mother Goose last time out, and **Sardula** (Storm Cat), who handed that filly her only defeat in the GI Kentucky Oaks. "I don't know of two fillies who dominate their division more than Lakeway and Sardula," said Don Warren, trainer of California-bred **Fancy 'n Fabulous** (Somthingfabulous). "If she winds up third, then I should at least get third money." Ten three-year-old fillies were nominated for the race, but at this point only **Malli Star** (Baldski) is considered a possible fourth runner. Trainer David Cross will send **Diane's Halo** (Sunny's Halo) to Belmont for the Coaching Club American Oaks instead. "I'm not running in the Hollywood Oaks unless I get a head start from Lakeway," said Cross. Lakeway is due to breeze six furlongs this morning; Sardula has completed her pre-race preps.

California shipper **KINGDOM FOUND** (The Bart) took the lead coming away from the gate, but was overtaken by Devil His Due after a half mile. The latter widened his lead to 1 1/2 lengths at the top of the stretch, but Valley Crossing narrowed the margin to 1/2 at the finish. "I thought he was struggling a little bit coming down the stretch," said winning trainer Allen Jerkens. "It looked like he got a little bit tired." Jockey Mike Smith agreed. "He got tired, but he just kept digging down for more. The thing that separates good horses from great horses is that they overcome top weight and farther distances, and that's what he did today." Jerkens said Devil His Due may have earned a rest until Saratoga's Aug. 27 Whitney H. Jockey Chris McCarron could find no excuse for the performance of Kingdom Found, sent off the second choice at 9-5. "He just stopped," said the rider. Runner-up Valley Crossing will head next to Monmouth's Iselin H. "Everytime I come up here, Jerkens beats me," said trainer Dick Small, "but then again, he beats everyone else, too."

ESPOM OAKS RUNNER-UPS CLASH AGAIN

Wind In Her Hair (Ire) (Alzao) and **Hawajiss (GB)** (Kris {GB}), second and third behind Balanchine in Espom's Oaks, will meet again in Saturday's Kildangan Stud-sponsored Irish equivalent at The Curragh. Others expected in the 12-furlong GI race are beaten Epsom runners **Bulaxie (GB)** (Bustino {GB}) and **Bonash (GB)** (Rainbow Quest), as well as Royal Ascot's Ribblesdale S. winner **Bolas (GB)** (Unfuwain). **Her Ladyship (GB)** (Polish Precedent), runner-up to East Of The Moon (Private Account) in the Prix de Diane at Chantilly, is also considered possible for the race.

CUP FULL FOR LOCHSONG Lochsong (GB)

(Song {GB}), Britain's Horse of the Year in 1993 and unbeaten in three starts this season, will face her strongest test of the year thus far in Thursday's July Cup at Newmarket. Slated to face the six-year-old mare are **Barathea** (Sadler's Wells), hero of last year's Irish 2000 Guineas, **Las Meninas** (Glenstal), winner of this year's 1000 Guineas, and **Owington** (Green Desert), successful recently in Royal Ascot's Cork And Orrery S. Other possibles for the six-furlong, GI event are **Catrail** (Strom Cat), **Dolphin Street** (Bluebird), **Lavinia Fontana** (Sharpo), **Splice** (Sharop), **Tropical** (Green Desert), **Piccolo** (Warning), **Redoubtable** (Grey Dawn II) and **Risky** (Risk Me).

MR. PURPLE POINTS TO JUVENILE Trainer Ron McAnally was sufficiently impressed with **Mr. Purple's** (Deputy Minister) three-length win in Thursday's third race at Hollywood to point him toward the \$100,000a Hollywood Juvenile July 25 at six furlongs. "He showed he was going to be good when he worked in the mornings," said McAnally of the colt, who beat the highly regarded 4-5 favorite **Houston Sunrise** (Houston) that day. "We had high hopes for him."

NUMBERS DOWN AT CHARLES TOWN MEET; VIDEO LOTTERY THE SOLUTION?

Both attendance and handle figures were down at the recently concluded spring meet at Charles Town race-track in West Virginia, which ran from April 1 through June 30. Attendance for the meeting was 119,478, down 11.5 percent from '93; handle totaled \$13,357,014, off 13.9 percent from last year. It is the 22nd consecutive Charles Town meet in which pari-mutuel handle fell from the previous year. Charles Town officials are seeking approval to install video lottery terminals at the track in an effort to stem losses experienced over the last three years. Three of the four West Virginia counties with tracks--Ohio, Hancock, and Kanawha--approved the machines during their May 10 primaries. Jefferson County voters will decide the fate of video lottery at Charles Town through a referendum Nov. 8.
