MONMOUTH NUMBERS STRONG THROUGH HOLIDAY WEEKEND

Business was booming at Monmouth Park over the holiday weekend, with attendance, on-track and total handle all up from last year's numbers. The total handle for Sat., Sun. and Mon. was \$11,469,333, a 15.6 percent increase from last year. On-track handle of \$5,559,518 surpassed the 1993 total by 3.6 percent, while attendance of 35,255 represented a 1.8 percent increase. Through the first 27 days of racing, total handle has been \$76.9 million, up over 13 percent. On-track attendance is down a slight 2.9 percent while on-track handle has decreased 3 percent. "We're really delighted with the expansion of our simulcast signal this season," said Hal Handel, Executive VP of Racing for the N.J. Sports Authority. "Because of the projected growth for simulcasting, we anticipated a slight weakening on-track. The good news on-track is the new faces we've seen all season with a different focus for our advertising and promotional campaign."

JOCKEY'S WEEKEND A SUCCESS

Over 1,700 fans came out to meet the jockeys and over \$3,500 was raised for the Don MacBeth Fund to benefit disabled riders this past weekend at Monmouth Park. Money was raised through sales of Don MacBeth Fund baseball caps, photos of the Monmouth Park jockey colony and copies of the Fred Stone print "One, Two, Three." The Monmouth Park jockeys, as well as Julie Krone and Steve Cauthen, autographed the prints and photos. Additionally, several hundred dollars were raised through jockeys who donated the \$40 they received for losing mounts.

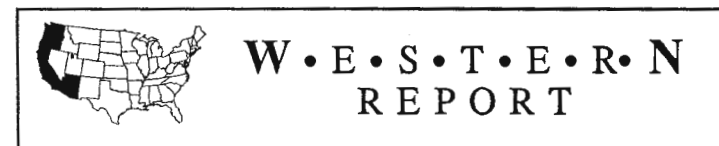

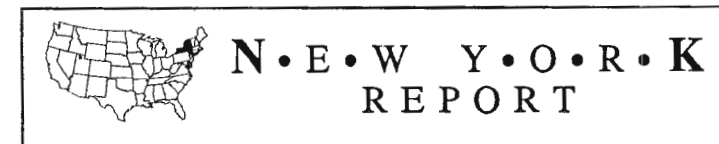
