### FRIED HAILS GIANT STEP FOR NY RACING

Albert Fried Jr., president of the NY-HBPA, expressed his gratitude yesterday on behalf of all New York-based owners to Governor Cuomo and the Legislature for their efforts in passing an omnibus racing bill over the fourth of July weekend. "We are delighted that the Governor and Legislature could agree on a package designed to move racing in New York toward where it belongs, on top," said Fried. "The provisions for a nine million dollar purse increase will enable horsemen to look forward to a 10 percent increase in overnight purses starting at the Belmont Fall meeting, a restoration of purse levels at Aqueduct to at least the 1993 level and possibly more (the winter of 1994 saw a 10 percent purse cutback) and a purse cushion rolled forward from the 1995 winter meeting to help increase purses by a solid 15 percent through the rest of the year."

### X-RAYS REVEAL NO INJURY TO BIEN BIEN

Trudy McCaffery and John Toffan's **Bien Bien** (Manila) was shipped to Nuclear Medicine Building at Santa Anita Mon. after trainer Paco Gonzalez discovered some heat in the right front foot of the MGI winner. According to Gonzalez, subsequent X-rays were negative, and it's still possible for the five-year-old to start in the July 24 GII Sunset H. at Hollywood. "His foot got a little hot, and we don't want to take any chances," Gonzalez said. "The X-rays were all clean, but we will get a second opinion." **Bien Bien** was vanned back to Hollywood Park Wednesday.

### LAKEWAY WORKS FOR OAKS GI Mother

Goose winner **Lakeway** (Seattle Slew) worked five furlongs in a bullet :58 4/5 Tuesday morning at Hollywood Park; trainer Gary Jones said she is ready for Sunday's GI Hollywood Oaks. "She's all set to go," said Jones. "All she'll do now is jog and school (in the paddock)." Brian Mayberry-trainee **Sardula** (Storm Cat) worked six furlongs in a bullet 1:11 last Thurs.; Mayberry confirmed that will be her last pre-Oaks work. **Fancy 'n Fabulous** (Somethingfabulous) remains the only other definite starter. Trainer Wally Dollase, who had been on the fence with **Malli Star** (Baldski), said Wed. she will skip the Oaks and run instead in Sat.'s \$60,000 Hidden Light at 1 1/16-miles over the Hollywood turf.

**Lochsong** (GB) (Song {GB}), Britain's 1993 Horse of the Year, is scheduled to face nine rivals. The Ian Balding-trainee, unbeaten in three races over five furlongs this season, takes on six for the first time since last autumn. Standing in her way will be **Barathea** (IRE) (Sadler's Wells), **Catrail** (Storm Cat), **Dolphin Street** (FR) (Bluebird), **Lavinia Fontana** (Sharpo), **Splice** (Sharpo), **Owington** (Green Desert), **Piccolo** (Warning {GB}), **Redoubtable** (Grey Dawn II) and **Risky** (Risk Me).

#### Sunday, Woodbine

**THE QUEEN'S PLATE S.-GI-Can**, \$396,579, 3yo, Canadian-breds, 10f

Trainer Mark Frostad put the final touches on **Bruce's Mill** (Steady Growth) Tues. morning at Woodbine, when the big gelding worked five furlongs in :58 3/5 seconds, galloping out three-quarters in 1:12. "That's exactly what I wanted," exclaimed Frostad. "The work sets him up perfectly." **Bruce's Mill**, installed as the early 9-5 favorite by Jim Bannon, oddsmaker for the Ontario Jockey Club, is owned by Earle I. Mack. Mack became the first U.S. based owner to win the Queen's Plate when his Peteski won last year's edition. Should **Bruce's Mill** win, Craig Perret would become the first jockey ever to win three successive Plates. **Parental Pressure** (Regal Classic) is listed as the second choice in the betting at 5-2, while the Frank Stronach entry of **Road Rush** (Broad Brush), **Basqueian** (Bounding Basque) and **Von Fleet** (Afleet) is currently 3-1. Rounding out the probable 11-horse field are **Barron Road** (Afleet), **Comet Shine** (Fappiano), **Dynamite Stuff** (Dynaformer), **Prix de Crouton** (Vilzak), **Tail in the Saddle** (Silver Deputy) and **Tuxedo Landing** (Waquoit).

**BROCCO POINTS TO DEL MAR** Brocco (Kris S.), forced to skip the Belmont S. when he suffered a bruised right front foot on the day of the race, won't make the GII Swaps S. at Hollywood July 23 as originally hoped, said trainer Randy Winick Wed. morning. "He's been going to the track and he's been galloping for three days, but he's not going to be able to make the Swaps," Winick said. "I hope to find a race for him the first week or two at Del Mar. His foot is fine. It's all healed up. But at a mile-and-a-quarter, the Swaps is just too far to go just on 3 1/2-weeks of training off of workouts." Brocco has not raced since finishing an eventful fourth in the May 7 Kentucky Derby.

### STEEPLECHASERS SET FOR SARATOGA

There will be 10 steeplechase races during the 1994 Saratoga Race Course season, kicking off with a \$30,000 allowance over national fences Wed., July 27 and highlighted by the \$100,000-added New York Turf Writers Cup, to be run Thurs., Aug. 18. Last year's Turf Writers winner **Warm Spell** (Northern Baby) will be back to attempt a repeat performance. Expected to challenge him are two-time champion **Lonesome Glory** (Transworld) and the highly regarded **Mistico** (CHI) (Balconaje {ARG}).
