THE WICKED NORTH OKAY AFTER SURGERY

The Wicked North (Far North) underwent surgery at Chino Valley Equine Hospital Thursday afternoon and according to his surgeon, Dr. Ted Fisher, everything went well. Fisher described the surgery as a "standard arthroscopic procedure", during which a chip was removed from the horse's right front ankle; the doctor also worked on a chronic wound on The Wicked North's left front shin. "The wound was not significant," said Fisher. "It was more of an annoyance to the horse than anything." The five-year-old is expected to be out of training for 60 to 90 days. "Eighty to 90 percent of horses with similar injuries are able to make complete recoveries," Fisher said. "There was no evidence of any other damage." The GI winner will stay at the hospital for two or three days before returning to trainer David Bernstein's barn at Santa Anita.

ANDERSON PARK INC. FILES MOTIONS WITH INDIANA RACING COMMISSION

Anderson Park Inc., owned by the Churchill Downs Management Company, yesterday filed a number of motions in front of the Indiana Horse Racing Commission, seeking reconsideration for a license to operate an off-track wagering facility in Merrville. API, owner of Hoosier Park, Indiana's first parimutuel racetrack which is scheduled to open Sept. 1, is asking that the motions be considered July 14, at the same time as Sagamore Park's Merrville application.

NATIONAL STUD BUYS FIRST TRUMP

The National Stud in Newmarket, England, has purchased the 3-year-old **First Trump** (Primo Dominie) to stand next season. The colt, who will continue to run for Moller Racing in '94, won five of six starts at two, including the GI Newgate Stud Middle Park S.

Cinnamon Sugar (Ire) (Wild Again), second to Lakeway in the Mother Goose last time out, tries a mile and a quarter for the first time. "According to her breeding, she should have no problem with the distance," said trainer Tom Skiffington. "Both her sire and her dam ran a mile and a quarter and won going long." A winner of two of her eight starts, the Irish-bred filly has been second in three of four stakes, including the first two legs of the Triple Tiara. She blew out for the race Friday, going three-eighths in :36.90. **Sovereign Kitty** (Sovereign Dancer) captured a mile allowance event by a nose in her most recent try. "Her last start was one of her best races to date," said trainer Rick Schosberg. "I really believe she runs her best when challenged." The Florida-bred has taken three of her four career victories by a nose, including the GIII Tempted S. last Dec.
