ATTENDANCE UP AT HOLLYWOOD PARK AS CASINO OPENS

Attendance at Hollywood Park racetrack rose six percent following the opening of the Hollywood Park Casino Friday, July 2. On-track attendance totaled 71,973 for the four-day Fourth of July weekend, as compared to 67,960 over the same period in 1993. "Attendance at the racetrack has been affected by the popularity of World Cup soccer in the Los Angeles area," Hollywood Park Chairman R. D. Hubbard said. "Entering Friday, on-track attendance was down 20 percent for the week, but we more than made up for the deficit over the holiday weekend." On-track attendance was up three percent for the meet going into Friday's card. Handle, which was down 0.6 percent for the Hollywood meet, was also up for the four days, increasing three percent over last year's figures. There were more than 30,000 visitors to the Hollywood Park Casino during the holiday weekend; handle on the races from the Casino was \$753,938 for the four days.
