MAJOR DISPERSALS AT KEENELAND

NOVEMBER SALE Two major dispersals will head the first day of Keeneland's annual November Breeding Stock Sale, to be held Nov. 6-13 this year. Greentree and Loblolly Stables will disperse breeding stock at Keeneland Sunday, November 6. Fifteen broodmares, 10 weanlings and 13 horses in training will be sold by Greentree. Between 15 and 20 mares will be offered by Loblolly, including Whiffing, the dam of the champion three-year-old of 1993, Prairie Bayou; she is in foal to Danzig. The mares are being sold to dissolve the partnership between John Ed Anthony and his former wife, Mary Lynn Dudley.

CALIPHA TO UNDERGO SURGERY Calipha (Two Punch), winner of the Gil Reeve Schley S. at Monmouth in her last start, is scheduled to undergo arthroscopic surgery at the New Bolton Center at the University of Pennsylvania today. "She was fine after the race, but last week we noticed she was sore," said Gerald Delp, assistant to trainer Bud Delp. X-rays revealed a chip in the filly's ankle. "The good thing is it's clean, so she'll come back 100 percent. After arthroscopic surgery, she should be fine." The Reeve Schley S. was the 3-year-old's sixth win from eight starts; she defeated Coaching Club American Oaks winner Two Altazano by seven in the race.

CARDMANIA ON THE COMEBACK TRAIL Eclipse Award-winning sprinter Cardmania (Cox's Ridge), who fractured his left hind cannon bone in February, has returned to trainer Derek Meredith's barn at Hollywood Park and is preparing for a return to the races. "The ankle is excellent," said Meredith. "Of course, we won't really know until he begins to gallop and puts some pressure on it. The plan is to begin galloping in another couple of weeks. We plan to give him as much time as he needs; he'll let us know when he's ready to pick things up."
