## JULIE KRONE IN SPILL AT BELMONT

Jockey Julie Krone suffered a badly bruised upper left leg yesterday after she fell from her mount, Doubtful Debt, when her saddle slipped during the third race at Belmont Park. It was at first feared that the tibia was fractured, but x-rays proved negative. "She is being released and is able to walk out of here," said Dr. Seth Labinge, attending physician at the North Shore University Hospital emergency room. Labinge added that Krone could be back in action in two days. The 30-year-old had only returned to riding May 25; she spent nine months on the sidelines after she was involved in a spill at Saratoga last August and severely fractured her right tibia.

## WORLD RECORD ON CALDER TURF

**Court Lark** (Court Trial), a six-year-old gelding trained by Michael Petro, set a new world record at Calder Saturday, sailing through seven-and-a-half furlongs on the turf in 1:26 2/5. The time was two-fifths faster than the previous world record, set by Finder's Fortune on the Hollywood Park main track April 29, 1993; the previous record for the distance on grass was 1:27 1/5, set by Joey Jr. at Hawthorne Race Course November 5, 1989. ## FULL-CARD SIMULCASTS FROM SARATOGA TO ATLANTIC CITY

Atlantic City Race Course has entered into an agreement with the New York Racing Association for full-card simulcasting, with commingled pools, of the Saratoga meet which begins July 22. The agreement is subject to approval at the July 20 meeting of the New Jersey State Racing Commission. "No doubt, this will be the most exciting addition to our summer racing schedule," said Atlantic City's Director of Mutuels and Simulcasting, Jim Miller. "Not only will Saratoga be a big draw, it should also help boost the handle on our other daytime signals." Added Chairman Robert P. Levy, "The added attendance should appreciably increase our simulcasting pools from Monmouth Park and should be a significant aid to overnight purses at both tracks." Atlantic City casino racebooks are prohibited from taking NYRA cards due to current legislation.

Fifth after a quarter-mile, Cherokee Run moved up to third by the half, then took the lead from front-running Fu Man Slew at the top of the lane and drew off to tally his first stakes win since the '93 Dwyer.

"He's a real competitor, running seconds and thirds against the top horses in the country this year," said jockey Craig Perret. "He's for real." Prior to this victory, the winner had been second in the GI Met Mile and the GII Tom Fool, and third in the GI Carter H. and the GIII Westchester H.; he is now three-for-three lifetime at six furlongs. A De Francis Day record of \$3,279,808 (including monies bet on full-card simulcasts) was wagered; the on-track crowd of 14,151 was the largest of the Laurel Summer Meet.

Trainer Allen Jerkens sent out **Sky Beauty** (Nijinsky II) for a mile work at Belmont yesterday morning. The winner of the GI Shuvee and GI Hempstead H. in her last two starts covered the distance in 1:38.25 with Mike Smith in the irons. The GI Go for Wand July 24 is the next stop for the four-year-old; Jerkens will also have two-year-old **De Niro** (Guich) ready for the GIII Sanford S. on opening day at Saratoga, July 22. "He'll ship up to Saratoga (today)," said Jerkens. "He's training good; he should be good and fit for the race on Friday." Two four-year-olds pointing for the Saratoga Cup Aug. 6 worked five furlongs: **Miner's Mark** (Mr. Prospector) went the distance in 1:02.21, while **Colonial Affair** (Pleasant Colony) was clocked in 1:00.42. **Sea Hero** (Polish Navy), prepping for the Daryl's Joy July 25 at the Spa; went five-eighths in 1:01.27, while fellow turf runner **Paradise Creek** (Irish River {Fr}) breezed the same distance in 1:03.10; the winner of the Early Times Triple Turf may make his next start in the Bernard Baruch Aug. 12.
