ANGEL CORDERO JR. SADDLES

FIRST STAKES WINNER Angel Cordero Jr., who won three Kentucky Derbies and two Eclipse Awards as a jockey, picked up his first-ever stakes win as a trainer yesterday, saddling the maiden **Holy Mountain** (Devil's Bag) for a surprising length-and-a-half victory in the Gill Lexington S. at Belmont Park. The Hall of Fame rider was quick to credit others for the success, however; Cordero is taking care of the three-year-old for trainer Bob Klesaris, who is currently serving a suspension handed out when Holy Mountain came up positive for Isoxuprine after winning his turf debut, a maiden special weight race, by six-and-a-half lengths at Belmont June 26. "I took over about three days ago," said Cordero. "It feels good to win, but it's not to my credit. (The Klesaris crew) are the ones that deserve the credit; they've had the horse a long time. I just came and watched him win." The second-longest shot in the field at 16-1, Holy Mountain was coupled with Cordero trainee Sangre De Toro, who finished eighth.

HOLY BULL BREEZES AT MONMOUTH

Holy Bull (Great Above), runaway winner of the Dwyer in his latest start, worked an easy six furlongs in 1:16 4/5 at Monmouth Sunday. The three-year-old colt is pointing to the GI Haskell Invitational at the Jersey oval July 31. "He was under tight restraint the whole way," said Daily Racing Form clocker Tyrone Artis. "He was never really asked to run. It looked like just a little more than an open gallop." Holy Bull will have his next workout between races at Monmouth Sunday, July 24. The first 10,000 paid admissions that day will receive a free Holy Bull button, and there will be a drawing for a framed picture of the colt signed by his jockey Mike Smith and his owner/trainer Jimmy Croll.

KRONE, LUTTRELL OKAY AFTER ROUGH WEEKEND AT BELMONT Jockey Julie Krone, who was involved in a spill at Belmont Saturday, escaped serious injury and will be back on track no later than Tuesday. "She's fine--just badly bruised," said her agent, Snake Cooper. "She was lucky, nothing was broken. I don't know about (Monday), but she will be back riding Tuesday." Apprentice jockey Michelle Luttrell, just behind Krone in the Belmont rider standings, was thrown from her mount, Wise-cracker, during Sunday's fifth race and was taken to North Shore University Hospital for precautionary x-rays. The colt, who was making his second career start and his first on the turf, had the lead at the eighth pole when he appeared to shy and made a left turn--right through the inside rail of the Widener turf course. According to New York Racing Association attending physician Dr. Bernard Brill, Luttrell suffered an abrasion to her right cheekbone and had pain in her knee and above her breastbone, but there were no apparent serious injuries. The horse received a deep muscle laceration on his right hip.
