## FIRST DAY OF KEENELAND SELECTED

**YEARLING SALE SHOWS GAINS** The first two sessions of the '94 Keeneland Selected Yearling Sale saw 105 hips sold for a total of \$24,270,000, up 12 percent over the 1993 gross for opening day. A total of 54 yearlings were sold in the afternoon session for a gross of \$12,900,000. The average of \$238,889 was up 7 percent from last year. The topper for the early session was a Mr. Prospector filly out of the GISW Jeanne Jones, consigned by Three Chimney Farms as agent, who sold to B. Wayne Hughes for \$675,000. Hip #136, a colt by Forty Niner out of Gana Facil, consigned by Gainesway Farm, agent for F. A. Genter Stable, attracted the high bid of \$900,000 for the evening session. The chestnut, a half-brother to Derby winner and champion three-year-old Unbridled, and to Grade I winner Cahill Road, was bought by Aaron Jones. "My wife loved him, my trainer loved him, and my vet loved him--I couldn't help myself," said Jones. "I'm sending him to California; Neil Drysdale will train him. He trained A. P. Indy, and he likes this colt just as well. I think he's about letter perfect. He's beautifully balanced and he seems to have a good disposition. If he doesn't run as good as he looks, I'll be disappointed." A total of 51 yearlings went through the ring during the evening session for a gross of \$11,370,00; the average of \$222,941 was up 9 percent from the 1993 average at the same session.

## BALANCHINE, ARAZI SHOW PROGRESS

**Balanchine** (Storm Bird) is making good progress following surgery to rectify an impaction in her small intestine. The Godolphin-owned filly, winner of this year's Epsom Oaks and Irish Derby, is still undergoing intensive post-operative treatment. But her gut has now started to function properly and it appears likely that she will make a full recovery. "Balanchine has improved a lot," said Godolphin's Manager Simon Crisford. "Her condition is no longer critical and she is on the road to good health." Meanwhile, **Arazi** (Blushing Groom {FR}), the subject of a life-saving bowel operation last week, has returned to his base at Sheikh Mohammed's Dalham Hall Stud. The stallion, winner of the 1991 Breeders' Cup Juvenile, is also recovering nicely.

## Saturday, Ascot, England

**GI £330,000 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S., 3yo/up, 12fT**

**Erhaab** (Chief's Crown), easy winner of the Epsom Derby before finishing a disappointing third in the Eclipse S. at Sandown, is early favourite for Saturday's GI event at Ascot. Also pre-entered for the mile-and-a-half race were: **Apple Tree (Fr)** (Bikala), **Bob's Return (Ire)** (Bob Back), **Chatoyant (GB)** (Rainbow Quest), **Environment Friend (GB)** (Cozzene), **Ezzoud (Ire)** (Last Tycoon), **Foyer (GB)** (Sadler's Wells), **Ionio (Silver Hawk)**, **King's Theatre (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), **Petit Loup (Danzig)**, **Richard of York (GB)** (Rainbow Quest), **Urgent Quest (Ire)** (Rainbow Quest), **Wagon Master (Fr)** (Rainbow Quest) and **White Muzzle (GB)** (Dancing Brave).

Early betting has Erhaab at 4-1, with Apple Tree, winner of the GI Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud and the GI Ever Ready Coronation Cup this year, at 9-2, and White Muzzle at 5-1.

## Sunday, Hollywood Park

**GII \$200,000 Swaps S., 3yo, 10f**

Golden Eagle Farm's **Dramatic Gold** (Slew o'Gold), impressive seven-length winner of a Hollywood allowance in his most recent start, heads a probable field of seven for the race. Also confirmed for the Swaps are **Powis Castle** (Rare Brick), GIII Affirmed S. winner **R Friar Tuck** (Religiously), **Silver Music** (Silver Ghost), last year's GI Hollywood Futurity victor **Valiant Nature** (His Majesty), **Wild Invader** (Seattle Slew) and **Pollock's Luck** (Polish Navy). Valiant Nature is looking for his first win of '94; the Kentucky-bred finished second to Holy Bull in the GII Blue Grass S., but was 13th in the Kentucky Derby. He came back two weeks later to finish third in the Will Rogers on the turf May 21 and makes his first start off the two-month layoff.
