SARATOGA TWO-YEAR-OLD IN TRAINING SALE TO BE SIMULCAST TO DEL MAR

The Fasig-Tipton July 27-28 Saratoga Selected Two-Year-Olds in Training Sale will be simulcast live to Del Mar, and buyers at the Del Mar Satellite Wagering Facility will be able to bid on the auction. The live program will be televised from 5:00 p.m. to approximately 9:30 p.m. Pacific time for the sessions of both Wednesday, July 27 and Thursday, July 28. Fasig-Tipton personnel will be at Del Mar both days, and will show videotapes of the individuals from the under-tack preview, to be held at Saratoga's main track July 26, prior to the sale each day. "This could not have happened without the full cooperation of the Del Mar Thoroughbred Club, and our thanks go to Joe Harper and his staff," said Fasig-Tipton President Walt Robertson. "Our sales coordinator, Geoff Russell, will be at Del Mar July 26, 27 and 28 to distribute catalogues, direct the simulcast operation and handle the live bidding. We hope this will be of service to the California Thoroughbred community and we are ready to expand the program to include the main yearling sale August 9, 10 and 11 if the demand is there."

HMM TO DISBAND Horsemen's Marketing & Media, an association of five state horsemen's groups, will disband, it was announced yesterday by HMM President Barry Weisbord. The decision to disband was reached through the collective agreement of all five groups, consisting of the HBPA affiliates in New York, California, Florida and Chicago, and the non-HBPA affiliated New Jersey Thoroughbred Horsemen's Benevolent Association.
