DEHERE BACK ON TRACK Dehere (Deputy Minister), who fractured his right hind cannon bone at Palm Beach Downs training center March 4 may resume training as early as next week, according to Due Process Stable Manager John Perrotta. "Further X-rays will be taken next week," said Perrotta. "If they're okay, and we fully expect them to be, we will put him right back into training." Perrotta said that Dehere would be pointed for a return near the beginning of the Gulfstream Park meet this winter. "We're very optimistic," said Perrotta, who added that veterinarians have informed the stable that the injury will not impede his racing future.

THUNDER RUMBLE TO SARATOGA CUP

Thunder Rumble (Thunder Puddles), the winner of the 1992 Jim Dandy and Travers, may make his next start in the Aug. 6 Saratoga Cup, according to trainer Richie O'Connell. The winner of a seven-furlong allowance race July 20, Thunder Rumble had returned to O'Connell, his original trainer, just two weeks prior to the win. "He seems pretty happy (at Saratoga)," said O'Connell. "We know he has a fondness not only for this surface, but for this environment. I think he remembered his past glories."

DE NIRO WILL WAIT FOR HOPEFUL De Niro, (Gulch) the 1-2 favorite who was third in Friday's Sanford, will likely make his next start in the Aug. 27 Hopeful S, according to trainer Allen Jerkens. "He's fine; he came out very good," said Jerkens. "He nicked himself behind, but that had no bearing on the outcome."

CHANGE OF PLANS FOR SEA HERO Sea Hero (Polish Navy), who had been expected to start in tomorrow's Daryl's Joy S., will be pointed instead to next Saturday's Sword Dancer H. at 12 furlongs on the turf. The 1993 Derby and Travers winner worked seven furlongs on the main track this morning in 1:27.83. "After Saturday's race, I have no idea what we'll do next. We may decide to go back on the dirt or keep him on the grass. It will be entirely up to him."

Ezzoud unseated rider Walter Swinburn at the start. The incident had a profound effect on the race, especially when the loose horse turned into the straight where he caused considerable interference to 7-2 favorite Erhaab, Foyer, Wagon Master and King's Theatre, while White Muzzle failed to get a clear run through on the inside at the critical moment. With a furlong and a half to run, King's Theatre took the lead and was switched to the inside of the riderless Ezzoud. Meanwhile, White Muzzle finally got through and ran on gamely for second while never seriously threatening King's Theatre. Erhaab, who suffered from the interference from Ezzoud, faded badly, as did Bob's Return, who had led the field into the straight after having exchanged the lead with Urgent Request for the first mile and a quarter. An unsatisfactory race, but at least ample compensation for King's Theatre, runner-up in both the Epsom Derby (to Erhaab) and the Budweiser Irish Derby to the brilliant filly Balanchine. Swinburn was taken to a local hospital with what were believed to be painful, but not serious, chest and rib injuries.

Making her stakes debut after taking her first three starts without a challenge, Twist Afleet went right to the front and battled Penny's Reshoot to defeat, driving to a length victory as the fourth choice over the sloppy track. "I'm really excited about this win, not just for me but for the owner," said trainer John Kimmel. "Her owner, Robert Maynard, passed away three weeks ago from a heat attack--he was only 45 years old. He was the first guy who actually gave me a chance with good horses, so he was a real special person to me. This win means so much, I can't even explain it. The horse now runs in his mother's name, but she's an elderly woman and couldn't be with us." Kimmel added that his unbeaten runner could make her next start in the Ballerina (August 19). Favored Heavenly Prize made up some ground through the stretch but could not threaten the top two.
