BERTRANDO RETURNS TODAY

Bertrando (Skywalker), the 1993 Eclipse Award-winning older horse, is scheduled to race today for the first time since finishing second in the Nov. 6 GI Breeders' Cup Classic. He is entered in the \$60,000a Wickerr H. at Del Mar, to be run at a mile over the turf course. The start, Bertrando's first on the grass, will also be his first for trainer John Shirreffs and jockey Pat Valenzuela. The five-year-old, who has been in the money in 15 of 16 lifetime starts for earnings of \$3,024,465 to date, has been training well since returning from a tour at stud duty. In his most recent work, he went a half-mile over Hollywood's fast main track Sun. in a bullet :46 flat.

GO FOR GIN BACK ON TRACK After two puzzling mornings in which Kentucky Derby winner **Go For Gin** (Cormorant) refused to gallop at Saratoga for trainer Nick Zito, the colt went through his morning routine Wednesday without any signs of hesitation. Scheduled for a work Monday over the Saratoga training track, Go For Gin balked each time his exercise rider tried to nudge him into a gallop. Zito tried taking the horse to the main track and changing exercise riders Tuesday to no avail. Wednesday morning, however, Go For Gin galloped perfectly and would have worked except for the fact that overnight rains had turned the training track into a sea of mud. "Physically, he couldn't look any better," said Zito. "It must be mental. Don't forget that he had a vacation and was let down. It's just like some people who don't like to go back to work after they've had a vacation. He went off just fine and galloped without a pony. He went on about his business just like he always used to." Go For Gin is scheduled to make his next start in the Aug. 20 King's Bishop S. at 7f.

But reigning champion jockey Pat Eddery switched his mount from a pocket on the rails and got up 50 yards from home to score by 1/2-length in course record time. Eddery, winning his fifth Sussex S., said, "Distant View is a really good horse and picked up brilliantly when I asked him to go. He didn't race at two, so he should improve again next year." This was trainer Henry Cecil's 4th Sussex S. winner. Distant View is 1/2 to Gypsy River (Hwt. older horse in Scandinavia twice, SW-Swe, by Alydar).

This is my first stakes winner up here, so I'm really thrilled." The win also marked the first in a Saratoga stakes event for trainer Burk Kessinger Jr. Trainer MacK. Miller said of 2nd-place finisher You'd Be Surprised, "She ran well. There are no excuses. She might have moved a little quick, prematurely." 8-5 favorite ELIZABETH BAY (Mr. Prospector) raced in 2nd behind early pacesetter IRISH LINNET (Seattle Song) most of the way before fading to last.

Darley Stud Management's **Cox Orange** (Tremolino), fresh off her July 3 victory in the Rockingham Budweiser BC, seeks her fourth consecutive stakes victory this year. The Christophe Clement trainee is a GII winner in both France and N.A. The late-running **Hero's Love** (Hero's Honor), Canada's Champion Turf Horse in '93, won the GII San Gorgonio H. at Santa Anita earlier this year. Always tough is seven-time stakes-winner **Via Borghese** (Seattle Dancer), who will be making her first start since finishing second in the GII Black Helen H. at Hialeah in April. **Logan's Mist** (Brogan), who led to the stretch in last year's edition of the Matchmaker before finishing third, will be back for a return engagement.
