SECOND FASIG-TIPTON SARATOGA TWO-YEAR-OLD SALE SHOWS MAJOR GAINS The Fasig-Tipton Saratoga Selected Two-Year-Old in Training sale, held for just the second time this year, showed major gains over last year's event. A total of 78 two-year-olds were sold during the two-day sale for a gross of \$2,926,000, up 87 percent from the '93 numbers when 74 hips sold in one session for a gross of \$1,561,900. The average for 1994 was \$37,513, up 78 percent from last year's average of \$21,107. The sales topper, sold during Thursday night's session, was Mystriarch, a filly by Storm Bird out of the Secretariat mare Crystal Cream; consigned by Nick de Meric, agent, the dark bay went for a bid of \$140,000 to Godolphin. A total of 72 two-year-olds that went through the ring were not sold.

PERCENT OF LURE'S EARNINGS TO BENEFIT EQUINE RESEARCH Claiborne Farm and Mrs. William Haggin Perry announced yesterday that one percent of Lure's (Danzig) future racetrack earnings will be earmarked to support equine research. Donations will go to the Grayson-Jockey Club Research Foundation's recently established Racing for Research program, which was launched by William Condren and Joseph Cornacchia, owners of Derby winner Go for Gin. Lure is scheduled to make his next start in the Bernard Baruch at Saratoga August 12.

RECORD ATTENDANCE FOR OPENING DAY AT DEL MAR A record crowd of 34,697 turned out Wednesday for opening day at Del Mar. It was not only a record for a Del Mar opener; it was also the largest single-day crowd in the track's 54-year history. The combined total attendance, including ITW sites, was 50,023, an opening-day record. Total handle for the day was \$9,166,281, up nearly 18 percent from last year.

Trainer Phil Johnson wheels **Kiri's Clown** (Foolish Pleasure) right back after the five-year-old's fifth-place finish in Monday's Daryl's Joy. "He was beaten five-and-a-half lengths--and it wasn't his distance," said Johnson. "It's unusual to run back like this, but this horse indicates he needs to run, so we'll give it a try." Trainer Tony Margotta is hoping **Turk Passer** (Turkoman) can repeat his latest performance, a longshot victory on the front end in the Bowling Green H. Said Margotta, "This is a horse with a lot of lung power, a lot of staying power. He's not the kind of turf horse who has to make his big run at the end of the race. We may use him differently this time."

"He's a tough, hard-knocking competitor," said trainer D. Wayne Lukas of his Preakness and Belmont S. winner **Tabasco Cat** (Storm Cat). "He's somewhat of an overachiever. When he won (the Fort Springs S.) at Keeneland at two, we thought he had potential to be a decent horse. I've always liked his action, and we let him develop without pressure." As a result, the colt has an impressive career record of 12-7-1-1. **Slew Gin Fizz** (Relaunch), scratched from Thursday's Screen King S., has been second in both starts at Saratoga, finishing behind Dehere in the GII Saratoga Special and GI Hopeful last year. The grey, a three-length Belmont allowance winner last out, tries a distance beyond a mile for the first time.

KEENELAND TO HOLD SALE AT RETAMA

PARK Beginning in 1995, Retama Park in San Antonio, Texas will be the site of a Thoroughbred auction conducted by Keeneland, it was announced yesterday. Keeneland will hold a two-year-olds in training sale Tues., April 11, during Retama's inaugural Thoroughbred race meeting, set to begin April 5. "Keeneland is very excited to be affiliated with Retama Park," said Keeneland President Bill Greely. The Retama Park sale is the only two-year-old auction currently scheduled in Texas. It will mark the first time in over 20 years that Keeneland has conducted a sale outside of Kentucky.

He faces **Bay Street Star** (Silver Buck), the front-running winner of the GIII Colin S. two back and 3rd to Holy Bull in the GII Dwyer last out. There looks to be plenty of pace in front of **Looming** (Broad Brush), who took his first 4 of the year but was a non-threatening seventh in the Preakness and third in the Colin in his most recent try. **Danville** (Demons Begone) moved into stakes company for the first time in the GIII Round Table at Arlington last time out, and defeated **Kandaly** by 2 1/4 at 17-1; the Kentucky-bred has been first or second in five of six starts this year.
