When analyzing **Tabasco Cat's** (Storm Cat) chances, the first thing we have to take into account is that Wayne Lukas is not a fool. His colt had a very strenuous spring campaign, and since then has been freshed and pointed not for this race, but for the Travers. **Unaccounted For** (Private Account) has only run four times, but his second figure was big and his third huge. His last was worse, but it was in the slop and best of all, he gets a gigantic weight concession worth almost six lengths at this distance. If the track is fast, the play is clear: **Unaccounted For** to win. *Thoro-Graph sheets, state-of-the-art performance figures, are used by many horsemen and professional handicappers to evaluate the ability of racehorses.
